H1: Enhanced NPIN Service Provider Finder Features for Easier Access

The National Prevention Information Network Service Provider Finder helps users gain access to HIV, STD, TB, and hepatitis service provider information. CDC recently updated it to provide users with more robust features and information. Now, users are better able to search and gather information by location with a simple, three-step process. Users will first set their desired location, then apply filters, and finally view their results.

H2: Updated Search by Location Features

Now, users will get more accurate and detailed results when they conduct a search. The advanced features help users find exactly what they are looking for in the location they need it in. Updated features include:

- 1) Search functions for state, zip code, and distance
- 2) New filters for testing services, languages, fees, and more
- 3) Two options for displaying results
- 4) Results of total clinics based on the search
- 5) Locations shown in list and map form

H2: Uses for the Search by Location Feature

This feature can help facilitate collaboration with nearby service providers found through the search. Users can also use this information to gauge the density of services in a jurisdiction of interest. The enhanced Service Provider Finder is a one-stop-shop for organization services as well as contact and fee information. Database information is also easily accessible for research or analysis projects.
