- **“Mamie Till” by Mariah Winslow** (honoring Mamie Till) – Mezcal Union, grapefruit, lemon, green tea thyme simple syrup and ginger beer. Available March 8-14.
- **“Caged Bird” by Paige Massey** (honoring Maya Angelou) – Drumshambo Gunpowder Gin, elderflower liqueur, strawberry simple syrup, lime and rhubarb bitters. Available March 15-21.
- **“Cool as a Cucumber” by Keena Hilliard** (honoring Marie Curie) – Vodka, lime, St Germaine, simple syrup, fruit-infused Pine Ridge Chenin Blanc. Available March 22-28.

For each featured cocktail purchased, Ida will donate \$1 to the [Junior League of Dallas](#) – a nonprofit organization of women dedicated to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women and supporting communities through the service and leadership of trained volunteers.
