



NARRITUE



Jason has directed multiple award-winning feature films and over 30 episodes of television. His latest feature film, <u>THE</u> ABANDON, scored a 92% rating on Rotten Tomatoes and was picked up by Lionsgate after premiering at the Mammoth Film Festival.
