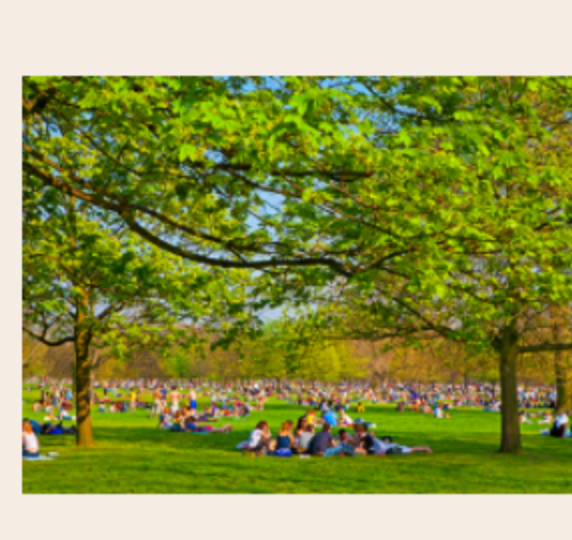

##### DAY 1

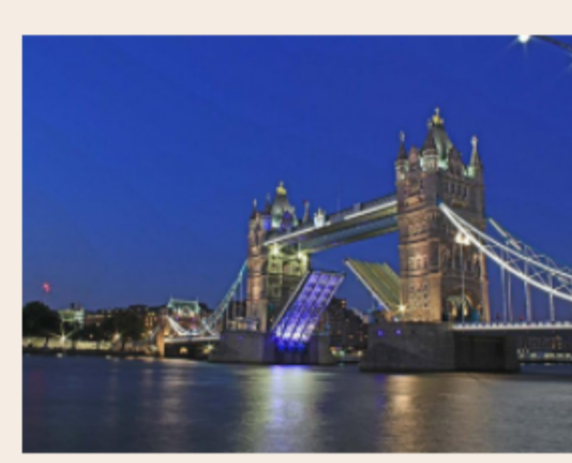
##### INSIDER TIP: STROLL ONE OF LONDON'S LARGEST ROYAL PARKS

Spanning 350 acres in the heart of London, Hyde Park is a beloved city centerpiece. Stop by Speakers Corner, a historical setting for public speeches and debates since the 1800s. Amble past seasonal blossoms in the Rose Garden. There's always something to do, from playgrounds and pedal boats to horseback riding and walking tours.

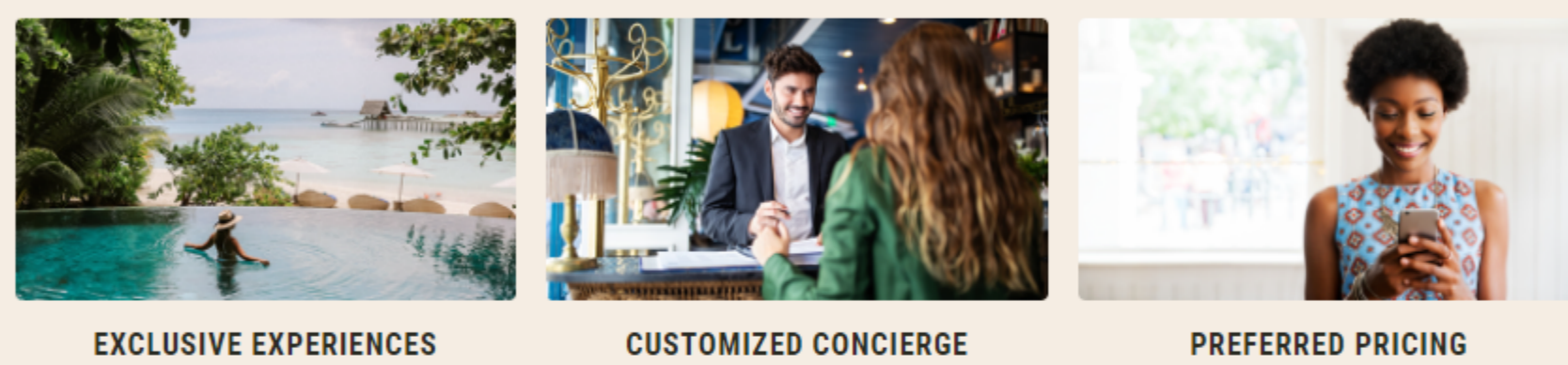
