LAS VEGAS, NEVADA

NATURE TREKS

Experience the natural wonders of the Mojave Desert at **Red Rock Canyon.** Less than 30 minutes from the Strip's neon lights is a glorious landscape of sun-drenched plains and colorful canyons. With rock climbing, mountain biking, dozens of hiking trails, and a 13-mile scenic roadway, you can choose your favorite way to explore.

WATER SPORTS


You don't have to go far from the Las Vegas Strip to kayak the Colorado River or soak in soothing hot springs.
