14 Best Men's Skincare Brands in 2022

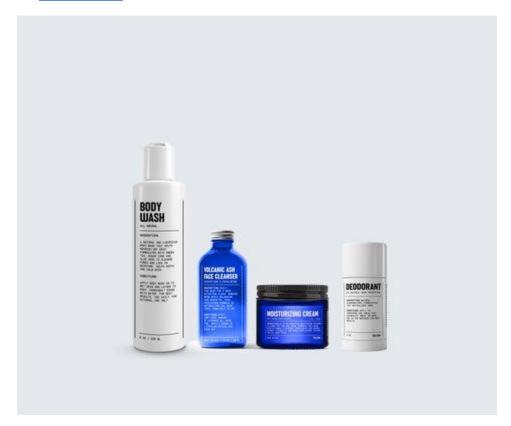

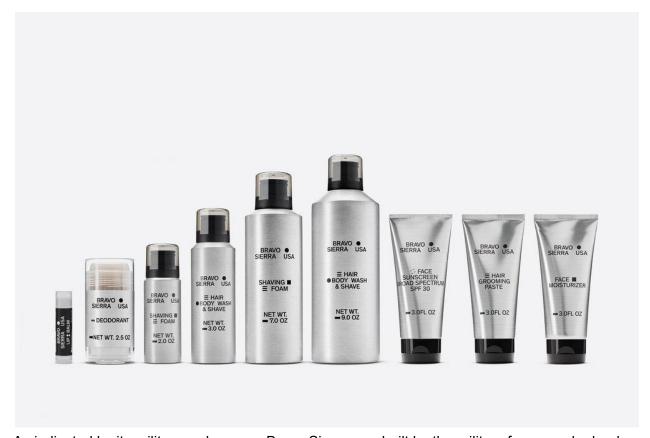
