With a small and slightly clunky search bar that is prone to lagging, the service could definitely be more user-friendly.

Prime Video is currently available to stream on:

- Xbox 360 and Xbox One.
- PlayStation 3 and 4.
- Casting devices, such as Google Chromecast, Apple TV, Roku, and Amazon Fire TV.
- Smart TVs.
- Blu-ray players by LG, Panasonic, and Sony.
- Set-top boxes such as Tivo and Dish Network.
- Android and iOS tablets and smartphones.
- Web-browsers, such as Google Chrome, Safari, Internet Explorer, Firefox, and more.
