About Range Rover

Before we get into the warranty details, let's take a look at Range Rover's history.

History

Range Rover is part of the Land Rover Brand. In 1885, Land Rover started as the Rover Company, a bicycle manufacturer in Warwickshire, England. 1948 saw the release of the first Land Rover, whereas Range Rovers began arriving in 1970.

The brand changed hands in ownership several times over next few decades. Then in 2000, Land Rover was sold to Ford. Finally, in 2008, Land Rover was sold with Jaguar to Tata Motors, establishing the Jaguar Land Rover.

Line-Up

Range Rover's lineup has changed since the prototype rolled off the lines in 1969. In 1970, the 3-door Range Rover classic hit the showroom floors.

It receives excellent reviews from the get-go, mainly due to its combination of elegant design and function. The Range Rover is the first vehicle to deliver permanent four-wheel drive and features a split tailgate, clamshell hoods, and continuous waistlines.

In 1981, Range Rover Classic was released as a four-door model. Later in 1994, the second generation of Range Rover's emerged with some minor changes that made it the vehicle we recognize today. Then, the third generation came out in 2001, introducing the first unibody-designed Range Rover.

The next several years saw the instruction of the Range Rover Sport (2005), the LRX Concept (2008), Range Rover Evoque (2011), Fourth Generation (2012), Range Rover Hybrid (2013), Range Rover Sport SVR (2015), Range Rover Velar (2017), and the Range Rover Fifty LE in 2020.

What's Included in a Range Rover Factory Warranty?

Factory warranties are designed to give you peace of mind about spending thousands of dollars on a vehicle. They will cover basic parts that may have had issues from the get-go. Here is a rundown of what these warranties cover and what Range Rover covers:

Bumper-to-bumper - Range Rover - 4 years/50,000 miles

Bumper-to-bumper warranty coverage means that the entire vehicle is covered, including the engine, transmission, and other essential systems. This type of warranty coverage is also known as a "full coverage" policy.

Roadside Assistance - Range Rover - 4 years/50,000 miles

Roadside assistance comes with many factory warranties. This service can include everything from changing a flat tire to jump-starting your battery and even help in the case of an emergency.

Emissions Warranties - Range Rover - 4 years/50,000 miles

This is a limited warranty that protects against damage to your engine. It's typically effective after 90 days or 3,000 miles, whichever comes first. This type of warranty is also essential for

cars with catalytic converters that may be missing. It's also worth noting that failing an emissions inspection in states that require them will void your emissions coverage.

Rust Perforation - Range Rover - 6 years/unlimited miles

This warranty addresses all of the repair expenses associated with corrosion damage on your automobile. Corrosion may be caused by scratches in the paint, vehicle damage resulting from a collision, water, salt, and other external factors.

Hybrid battery - Range Rover - 8 years/100,000 miles

This warranty covers the battery in hybrid model cars. The battery will need to be replaced at some point in the life of a hybrid. If it happens before eight years or 100,000 miles, Range Rover will cover it.

Standard battery - Range Rover - 4 years/50,000 miles

This is the warranty for a gas-powered vehicle. Batteries don't last forever, and you might need them during the time you own your vehicle.

Adjustments - Range Rover - 12 months/12,500 miles

The dealer provides this coverage and includes minor repairs, squeaks, rattles, tiny adjustments, alignments, leaks, and any other sort of minor irritation you might experience during the first few weeks of ownership.

Can I Get an Extended Warranty for My Range Rover?

Yes, you can get an <u>extended warranty</u>, and you should! Once the factory warranties we just mentioned run out, <u>Range Rover repairs</u> can be expensive. Here are a few examples of the repairs you can expect to pay for:

- Steering Gearbox Replacement \$2,294 and \$2,369.
- Engine Oil Pan Replacement \$1,733 and \$2,186
- Active Suspension Air Spring Replacement \$761 and \$811

No one wants to pay for these out of pocket; that is why extended coverage is a fantastic investment. Keep in mind, as lovely as Range Rovers are, they have ranked <u>15th out of 19 with a 2 out of 5 with RepairPal</u>.

So why pay for repairs after that factory warranty runs out? Don't look into an extended warranty that will cover those costs.
