1977- 1980 Part owner of a Ranger 33 that we raced and cruised along the NE coast. Helped deliver a Pearson 30 from New Bedford to Stamford CT.

1981-2007 Helped a good friend & neighbor in Fairhaven, MA as an occasional deckhand on his 65' salvage Tug "Jaguar". In 1981 assisted in the salvage of two fishing vessels in one night during a Feb gale on Buzzards Bay and in Woods Hole, MA, one of many towing and salvage incidents.

1982-85 - Owned a Puma 23 that I raced and cruised in Buzzards Bay also raced with friends on a Pearson 26 followed by a Irwin 31.

1985 - Assisted in the delivery of a Bermuda 40 from Fairhaven to Seal Hbr, ME.

1986 - Raced with friends on a Tartan 41 including offshore races (Towers Race, Whalers Race) Also competed on this boat in club racing.

1987 Purchased a Sisu 22 bassboat and delivered it myself from Portsmouth NH to Fairhaven MA.

1990 - Refurbished a Bettlecat that we used for family recreation in New Bedford Hbr. for a number of years.

1993 - Obtained and maintained a Scampi 30 sloop as a test and promotion vessel for my company. Raced the boat in club races through the summer.

1994 - Placed 4th in class in the Figawi race with Scampi and did well in club racing

1996 - Rented 23' powerboats in the Abacos for family day trips

2000 - Raced with friends on a Bristol 43 and a Aerodyne 38, bought and refurbished a J 24 with a good friend.

2001 - Chartered a Morgan 43 in the Abacos with friends together with 23' powerboat, I ran the powerboat.

2001 - 2007 Club raced and day sailed J 24 and did quite well

2006 - Rented a 23' powerboat in the Abacos for exploring with friends.

2007 - Rented a 26' powerboat for two days of exploring in the BVI

2008 - Helped deliver a Lagoon 43 from St Martin to Kemah TX

2009 - Helped friends with a charter of a 43' Cat in the Abacos.

2013 - Raced on Express 37 and U20 in Galveston Bay.

2013 - July - helped deliver a 76' Aluminum sloop from St Martin to Newport RI

2013 - Oct – crewed on a C&C 38 “Firewater” in the Harvest Moon Regatta race from Galveston to Port Aransas ~250 miles

2013- Sept. Crewed on a Bavaria 43' from Port Hardy BC to Victoria BC.

2013 - Nov. helped to deliver a 76' sloop from Newport RI to Norfolk VA, in November gales.

2014 - Spring, round the buoys racing in Galveston Bay on a J27

2015 - Feb, March April, round the buoys racing on a J27, day sailing on an Express 34, assisted in a short coastal delivery of a Jeanneau 46

2015 - May, chartered a Jeanneau 41 and sailed with friends round trip from Newport to Nantucket. Head winds of 25-30 kts from Nantucket to Newport.

2016 – Raced on an Express 34 in Galveston Bay (Rum Race) in a 40 boat fleet, took second in class. Sunday day sailing on the Express 34 and a J 27.

2016 - helped move a Tayanna 37 from Astoria OR to Port Angeles WA, crossing the Columbia River Bar. September, helped move a Contest 31 from Newport RI to Gloucester MA. Then did a Wed night race on Fayal, Bristol 43 took first and sailed from New Bedford to Oak Bluffs MA on an O'Day 32.2.

2017 - Jan. raced in GBCA Icicle Series on J 27, placed in fleet, April, chartered a 50 ft Jeanneau sloop with friends and cruised the BVI for a week.

2018 - Sailing in Texas on Express 34 with friends competed in a race on a J27, Galveston Bay where it rained an inch an hour. The visibility was so bad that we needed the GPS to find out way to the harbor entrance which was only ¼ mile away form the end of the race

2019 - shipped out on a 56' wooden English cutter for 3 of sailing on the Celtic Sea in Oct. passenger/crew

2020 - Sailed with the boys in St Martin on a Jeanneau 49. We were nearly stranded by Covid and barely got off the island.

2021 - Day sailing on a Benneteau 50 in Cabo San Lucas, the Capt'n turned the helm over to me.

2022 - Day sailing on a Choy Lee 36' yawl in Newport RI, day sailing on a 32' Friendship sloop in San Diego

Oh, I should add that I crewed on the oil tanker Mobil Fuel in 1967 for one summer as an OS.
