Your **Animal Bailee policy** responds to the accidental injury or loss of patients that your practice boards or transports. **However, an Animal Bailee policy can only provide protection up to its limits.**

What is a Policy Limit?

A limit is the maximum amount of money that an insurance policy will pay for an individual bailee claim or loss.

Low Limit Bailee Policy Results in \$3,000 Loss

A Corgi boarding at Dr. A's practice escaped and was never found. The owners filed a lawsuit against Dr. A's practice demanding \$5,000 for their canceled vacation, flight change fees, cost of printing "lost dog" posters, the purchase of a new dog, and more.

Dr. A had secured Plan 1 Animal Bailee Insurance through the PLIT Program with a \$2,000 per incident limit. The policy was only able to pay the \$2,000 limit, and **Dr. A had to pay the remaining \$3,000 out of pocket**. With a higher limit bailee policy, the loss would have been covered in full.
