My Book World Edition network storage drive

What is it? It's Western Digital's (WD) newlyredesigned network storage drive that makes light work of the critical (but tedious) task of backing up an entire household's precious files.

We like it 'cos it offers plug-and-play installation and automatic continuous backup. Music, photos and videos can be streamed

directly from the drive to any PC, Mac or connected DLNA media player (such as Xbox 360 or PlayStation3, wireless digital picture frames or TVs).

It will be available in 1 terabyte, (TB) and 2 TB capacities, so say o'bye to piles of CDs, DVDs or USB thumb drives.

How much is it? 1TB retails for R2 500. including VAT.

Where can I get it? Through selected retail outlets (try Incredible Connection stores, nationwide).

wind it What is it? Wind Charger

What is it? The New Scarlet telly from LG that boasts the world's slimmest LCD design (only 39.7mm).

We like it 'cos it's an HDTV that not only looks like Angelina Jolie, but is also easy to set up and adjust (probably unlike Angelina Jolie). It has Bluetooth (play music and photos on the screen from your cellphone or listen to the TV via a Bluetooth headset): Smart Energy Saving (the intelligent sensor uses up to 69.5% less energy, by sensing colour temperature and the light of the surroundings and adjusting key elements like brightness, contrast, colour, sharpness, white balance and the intensity of the back light); invisible speakers (custom-tuned by audio expert, Mark Levinson) and USB 2.0 (you can plug all sorts of other things in).

What is it? The dot: the world's first 8.9-inch netbook.

We like it 'cos it was designed and engineered through the eyes of a family, not a company. If the notebook is the main family car, then the dot is a scooter. It is ideal as an additional PC/ internet access point for the whole family and the full Windows XP operating system provides users with the features and interface they know so well (it's not Vista!) The Intel Atom processor and 1GB of RAM make performance zippy and battery lifelong. The 160GB hard drive, 3 USB ports and 5-in-1 card reader make it perfect for off-loading a digital camera. The dot is a born communicator, thanks to its built-in Wi-Fi (b/g), the optional 3G module and integrated webcam.
