With apologies to Mr Shakespeare...

To be sponsored or not to be sponsored, that is the question:
 Whether 'tis nobler in the mind, to suffer
 The don't-knows and maybes of potential sponsors,
 Or to grin and bear their unfathomable demands,
 And by doing so...get the sponsorship,
Ah...that is the true question...Is it worth the bloody hassle?

In a word, Absobloodylutely! Anyone who has had experience in the performing arts knows the importance of the sponsorship dollar. The cold hard fact remains...without sponsorship Malaysian performing arts would die a sudden death; more gruesome and horrific than in any of Shakespeare's tragedies.

緣起

新纪元学院是昔日加影华侨学校的所在地、当年他们非常热心于 教育、也吸引了不少海外的华裔子弟来此地留学。除此之外,华 侨学校的戏剧活动也非常地活跃,而且还带动了加影城的文化 活动。由于当时的文化、教育活动的兴盛与蓬勃,让加影赢得 了"文化城"的美誉。可是,在1948年6月英殖民地政府颁布的 紧急法令之下,华侨学校停办,一切的文化活动就从此消声匿 迹…50年后的1998年,新纪元学院在加影的设立,象征了高等 教育文化在加影社区的萌芽。

2004年,新纪元学院在此地增设戏剧与影像系,并在翌年建设 黑箱剧场,让演艺活动在加影拥有了一个发展的平台。这一连 续的事象,似乎是延续了昔日加影"文化城"的渊源,象征着 专业演艺文化活动在加影的重生与滋长。

由此,藉着新纪元学院在筹办创设10周年纪念庆典之际,换言 之,在文化城消逝60年后的2008年里,提议举办一个社区艺术 嘉年华会作为一个开发加影社区文化的契机与开端,希望透过 与社区实质的互动和激荡,有朝一日能再次创造另一个属于当 代的文化城!

目的

In the last few years, SALSA has become one of the "in" dances to learn in Malaysia. The origins of Salsa cannot be tagged to a particular country though it is generally thought to have been started by the Cubans and has over the years become a combination of many Latin and Afro-Carribbean dances.

Why Salsa? Well, Salsa is a very flexible dance that continuously evolves over time and can be danced either with a partner or even alone. Unlike some other mainstream dances, Salsa is not a very complicated or rigid dance and allows room for improvisation on the steps learnt, combining body and head movements ranging from the simplest to the sexiest and even various spins while maintaining the basic steps i.e. dancing on a recurring eight-beat pattern (two sets of four beats). With just a few basic steps, one is able to come up with combinations for social dancing on the floor. Yes, even those who claim to have two left feet!

The goodness of Salsa is that it can be both a disciplined and/or a fun dance with a combination of many basic steps. This also depends on whether one is going for the very beginner moves or the very advanced moves. It also allows one to be creative with the steps learnt. Its music is generally upbeat and fast with music from various instruments such as the conga, maracas and bongo amongst others. Salsa music combines various beats and gives out very different feels while maintaining the recurring eight-beat pattern and can be both relaxing and exciting!

Because of the type of music, the different styles and varieties of movements that have developed over time, Salsa has become a very popular dance to learn as it gives one a very carefree even playful feel if you will and one need not have a particular partner to learn salsa! The general rule of thumb would be the gentlemen to lead and the ladies to understand the lead.

So put on your dancing shoes today and experience what Salsa has to offer!



Cyci Mata, Cyci Hati

I was amused. I was awed. I was scared. I was confused. I was melancholic, but most of all, I was moved by MATAHATI's exhibits that were on display in Galeri Petronas. It's a lot like falling in love and I did indeed, with so many of the paintings, that I wished I was married to MATAHATI. Ah, but if only MATAHATI were a person. In fact, MATAHATI is a collective of persons consisting of Ahmad Fuad Osman, Ahmad Shukri Mohamed, Bayu Utomo Radjikin, Hamir Soib and Masnoor Ramli Mahmud. These artists met each other in UiTM and after graduating in 1991, formed MATAHATI.

MATAHATI have made themselves responsible for representing a voice for themselves and the community especially in an environment where the cloaks of censorship are thrown left, right and center

It's interesting to know that when translated, MATAHATI means 'eye of the soul'. Poetic, isn't it? Their name reflects the kind of visual poetry they create. I recall a friend educating me about 'cuci mata', a Malaysian slang used when eyeing good-looking people. It can be used to describe what I was doing in the gallery, except I ogled art not people. After satisfying my heart's desire and my eye's hunger for art, I walked out of the gallery with a desire to tell my friends about the "hot stuff I checked out" in KLCC.

MATAHATI are touted as Malaysia's leading art collective, and it's really no wonder. I was blown away by their work. Compared to the overabundance of glossy advertising images we witness everyday, I love how the exhibition felt raw and incredibly human. You see, I've only been to a small number of badly curated – I mean, amateur – exhibitions and also come from a background where, most times, aesthetics come without a message. It's amazingly refreshing to be able to cast my eyes on a piece that has something valuable to say.

MATAHATI have made themselves responsible for representing a voice for themselves and the community especially in an environment where the cloaks of censorship are thrown left, right and center. The artists are cultivating the opportunity to start a dialogue through art. Richly textured and layered with authenticity and relevance, the works explore many themes including humanity, community, history, culture and religion.

Each individual will have their own experiences to relate with the pieces and even if you're a foreigner like me, you'd still find something relevant. That's the beauty of their work. The pieces have personality and they are personal with views that will nudge you to ponder, question, debate and react. They simply wait for the public to come around and give them a chance to "speak".

From what I've seen at this exhibition, I know there is bound to be at least one painting, sculpture or installation that will automatically draw you in. If there isn't, as Bart Simpson says, I'll eat my shorts! Bets aside, the exhibition ends on April 13, so get off your sleepy bum and go as this exhibition showcases the largest number of MATAHATI's selected works to date.

I recommend going alone. Even better, go on a weekday. If accompanied during a weekend, refrain from communicating with others and soak yourself in the experience. You'll encounter a degree of intensity as you walk through a dimmed gallery in contemplation. At least, that's what I felt when I put myself in the zone of solitude accompanied by the ambience and the poignant exhibits that helped me 'cuci mata', 'cuci hati'.

OFFICIAL MESSAGE FOR DANCE DAY 29 APRIL 2008

Governments, sponsors, and the media is our main concern this year.

Governments (national, regional or local), sponsors (private or public) and the media (newspapers, magazines, radio, TV) are the three most important factors affecting the practice of our art. Dance professionals struggle to approach them individually - with poor results. We propose a better way: through CID Sections representing all forms of dance, all levels, all functions.

I invite all dancers to join the International Dance Council and to form CID Sections. These Sections will be able to tackle general issues affecting dance. Through them, as officially recognized bodies, all dancers can secure better conditions for the practice of their art. They will be able to obtain appropriate regulations from governments, adequate support from sponsors, and satisfactory visibility from the media.

We propose to replace self-centerred isolation with concern for the common good. Each one of us has been trying to get some crumbs, by working together we will increase the size of the cake.

CID is certainly not a trade union, but CID Sections can act as pressure groups on the local and the national level. They can persuade. Their force arises from the fact that they represent the entire spectrum of dance.

They can convince the environment where dancers evolve that their art is essential for the well-being of every society.






