The collective aims to raise enough funds to complete their Super-Farmer Project in Bali, training farmers on sustainable practices that help farmers and the local ecosystem.

Permaculture is an approach to agriculture that harmonizes the interaction between humans, resources, and the natural environment to the mutual benefit of all. Permaculture practices work with, not against nature, leveraging the natural tendencies of the land, animals, weather, plants, and other resources to develop a system that sustains human needs while also nurturing the environment.

Green Warrior Permaculture's new site describes their Super-Farmer Bali project which helps farmers in Bali retain their land through profitable and sustainable farming practices. Many farmers in Bali, strapped for money, have left farming, and sold their land to developers aiming to turn the land for tourism.

The strategies implemented through the Super-Farmer project will increase the profitability of farming, allowing the farmers to retain their land. The project will also improve water quality by reducing reliance on pesticides and help rehabilitate birdlife populations in the area.

Green Warrior Permaculture was founded by Steven Cran, a sustainable community development specialist who started his work in permaculture aid with rural Aboriginal communities in Australia.
