What is the "colour of the season" this winter? And how can I add it to my wardrobe?

Pantone Colour is a colour-matching system universally used by many industries. Pantone unveils a colour of the year and the top colours for each season (spring/ summer and autumn/ winter). For autumn/winter 2019, these are punchy rich red tones (like burgundy), olive greens, bold blues and golden yellows. To incorporate these hues without making a huge commitment, introduce them in your accessories, such as a bag, shoes, belt, jewellery, hat or scarf. Or invest in a key piece like a jacket or coat that can be worn with existing wardrobe staples. A jumper is another way to incorporate seasonal colours. Punchy reds work well with beige, cream, caramel and navy tones. Olive greens can be worn with denim, camel and black tones, and blue hues look great with black, gold or cream.
