What is the best way to sort and pack your wardrobe when moving to a new city?

Al'm sure there are many of us who at some point in our lives will benefit from this advice and information!

The first step always is to clear out or purge your wardrobe. There is no need to pack and pay for moving clothes that you'll never wear again or that don't fit. Be sensible, realistic and diligent. Be brave.
