## ALASKA MARITIME NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE CENTER

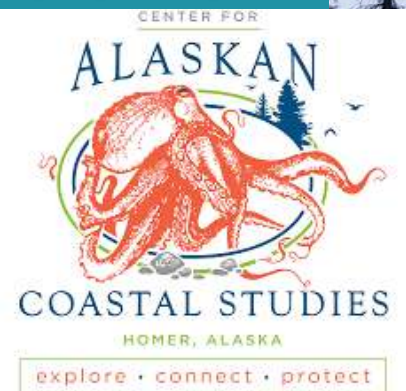
