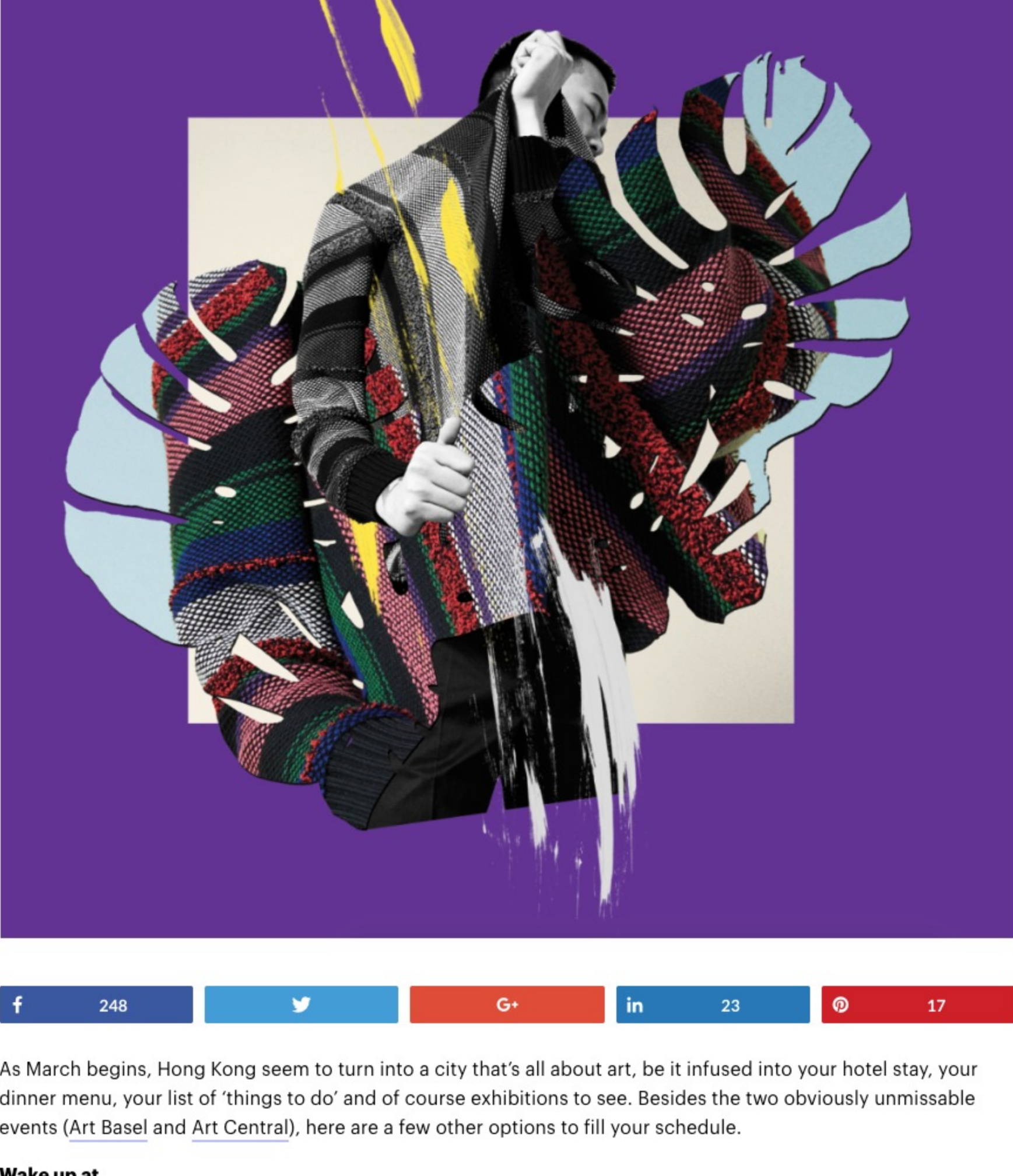

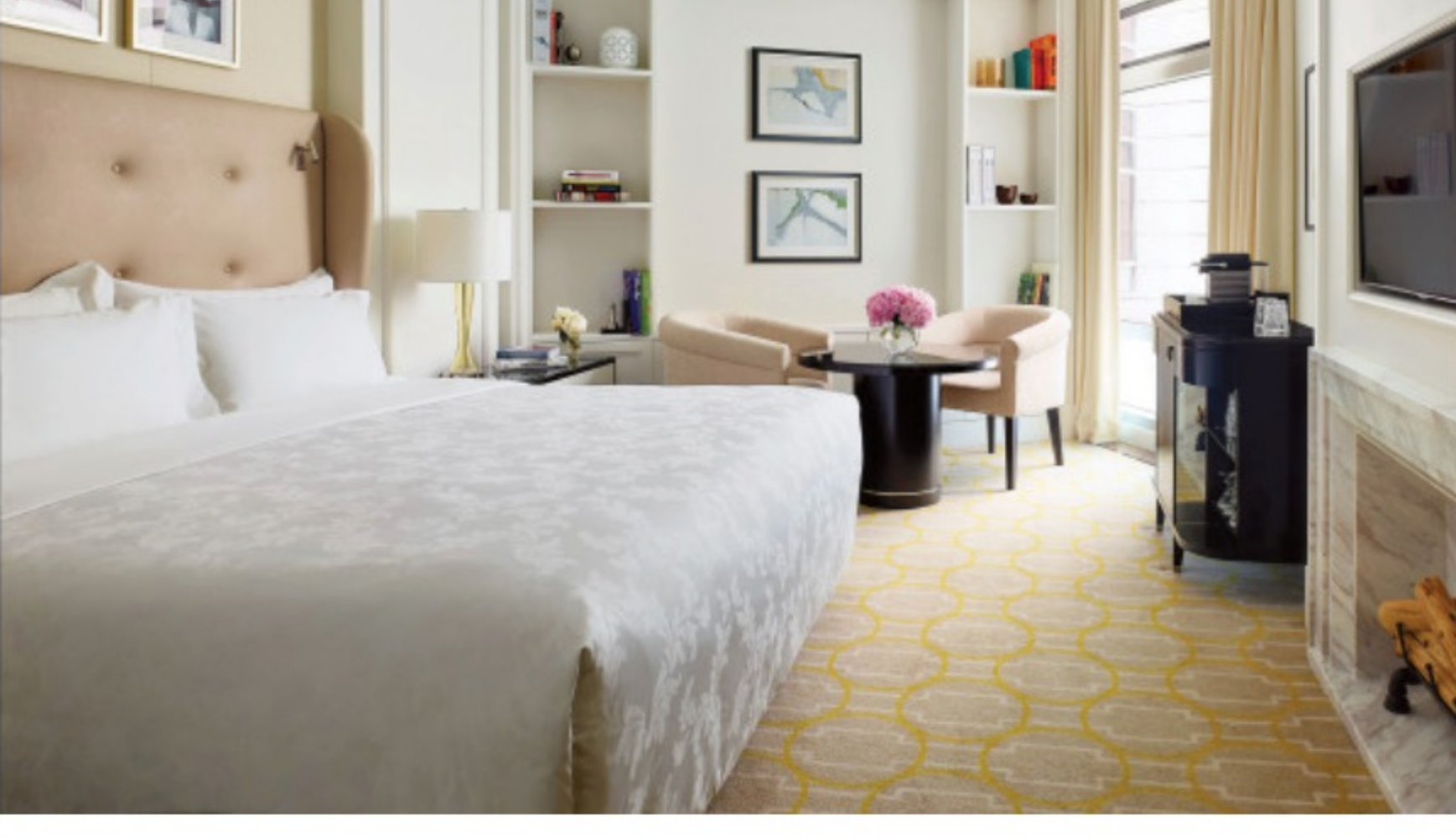
# Where to go during Hong Kong Arts Month 2017

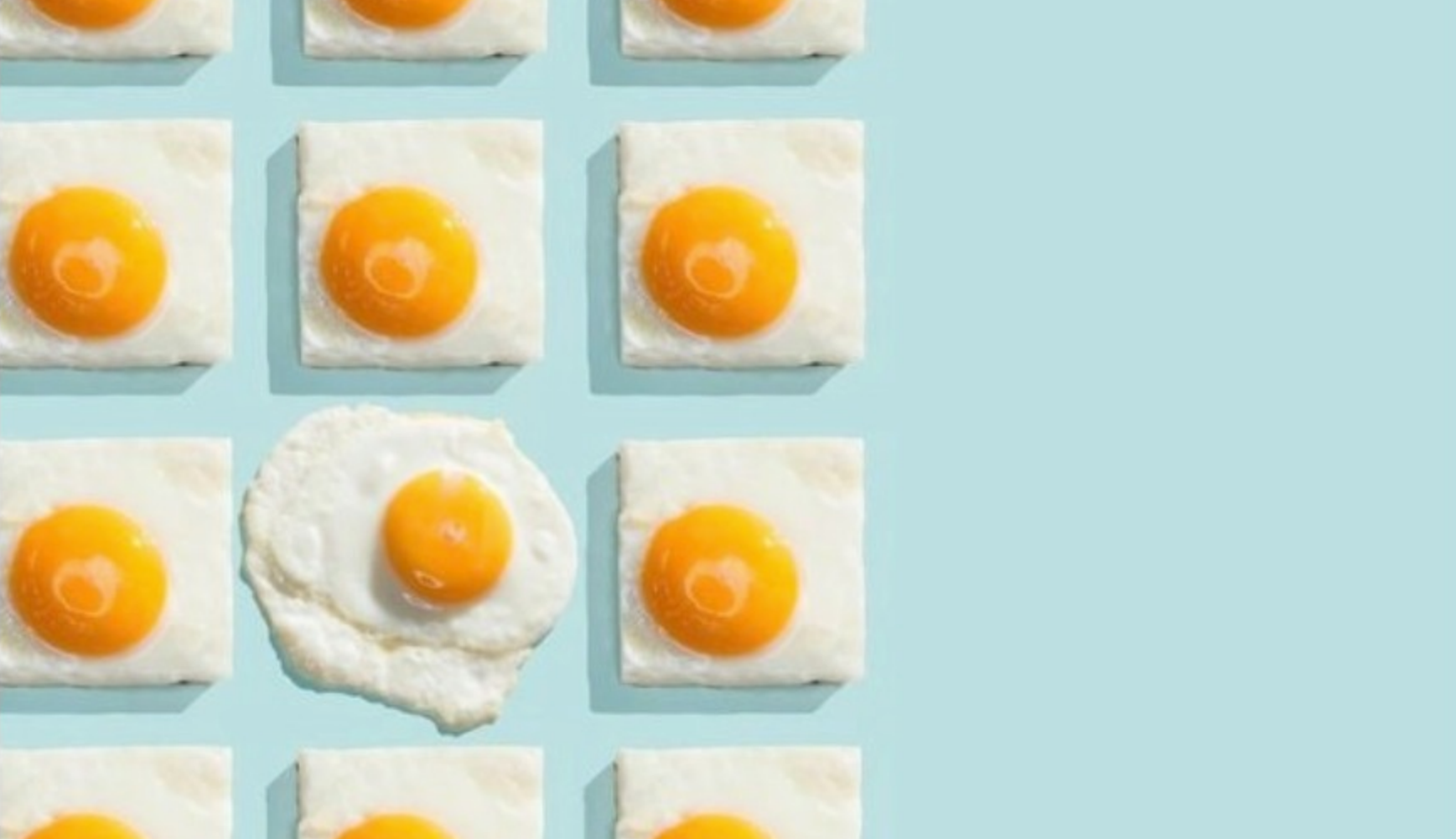
### Wake up at...

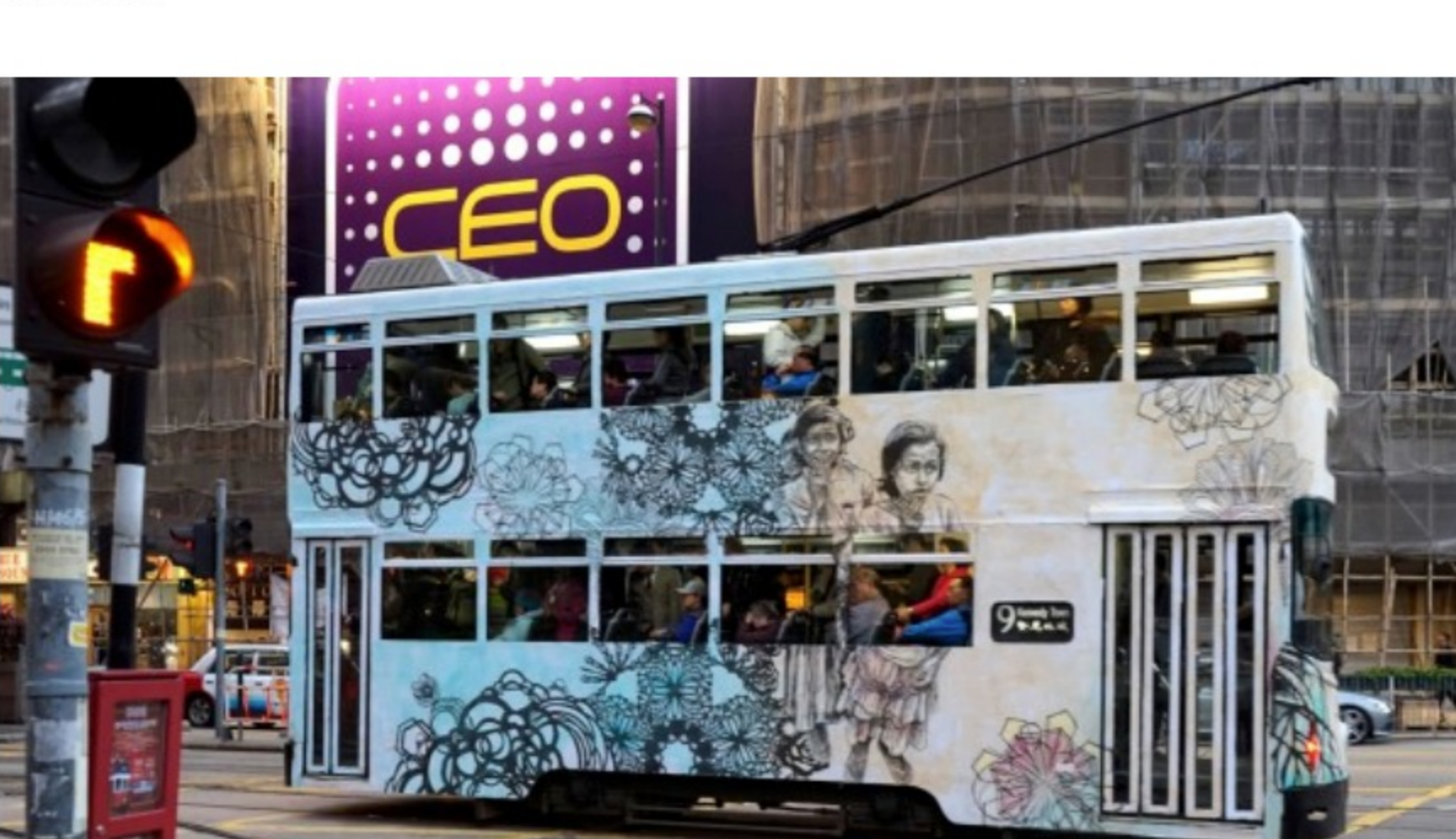
### Have breakfast at...



### Commissary

Before visiting the Asia Contemporary Art Show at The Conrad, pop into Commissary for a quick bite. They've got fresh baked pastries as well as hearty dishes like avocado toast and five-minute egg with espetette, Chilaquiles (lightly fried tortillas with cheese and eggs) and more.

### HKWalls 2017 (March 18-26)

For a dose of local art, be sure to hit Wong Chuk Hang and witness HKWalls, Hong Kong's annual street art festival, in all its glory with live mural paintings, exhibitions and more. There will be an art battle on March 24, but if you can't make it to the Southside, you can always catch the Art Tram by Swoon running along Hong Kong island.

### Harbour Art Fair (March 7-28)

Visit the first edition of Harbour Art Fair for a dose of Korean contemporary art housed inside Marco Polo Hong Kong Hotel. There will also be special art exhibitions from four emerging Korean artists displayed at Harbour City.

### Zaha Hadid: There Should Be No End To Experimentation (March 17 - April 6)

Head to ArtisTree to admire the critically acclaimed and largest exhibition to date featuring the late Zaha Hadid's early paintings. There will also be never-seen-before exhibits and interactive VR experiences. An exhibition not to be missed.

### Le Marche

While you're at Art Central, head to Le Marche, helmed by chef Philippe Orrico of Upper Modern Bistro and the Michelin-starred ON dining. The pop-up restaurant will be serving casual French dishes, wine and cheese, as well as cocktails.

### Taste of Hong Kong (March 16-19)

For foodies, don't miss the annual Taste of Hong Kong, where the crème de la crème of the local dining scene gathers in one location to present festival-exclusive and signature dishes. This year, sample dishes from restaurants like Amber, Kei Restaurant, Okra, Yardbird and more.

#### Initial at Art Central

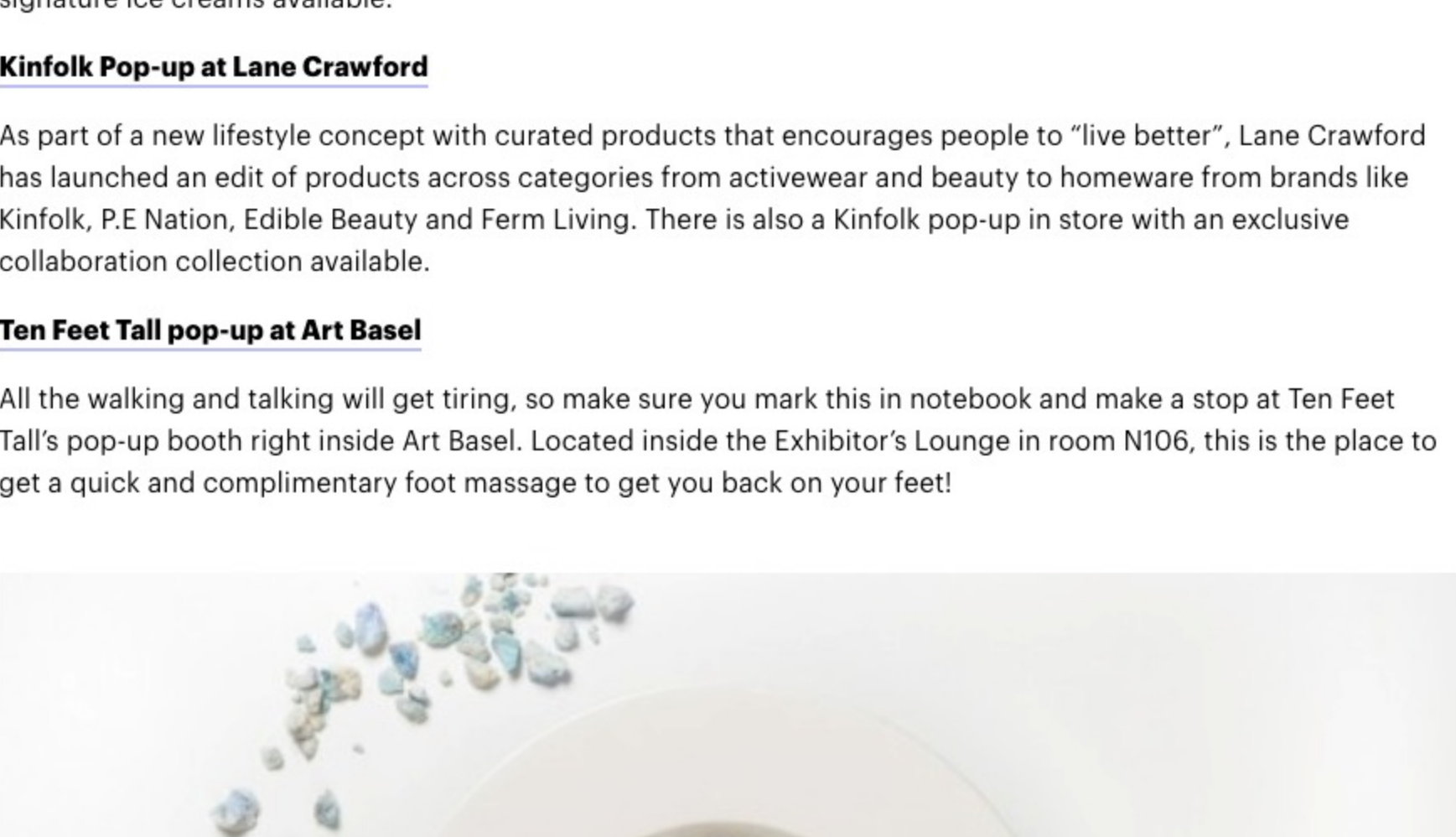

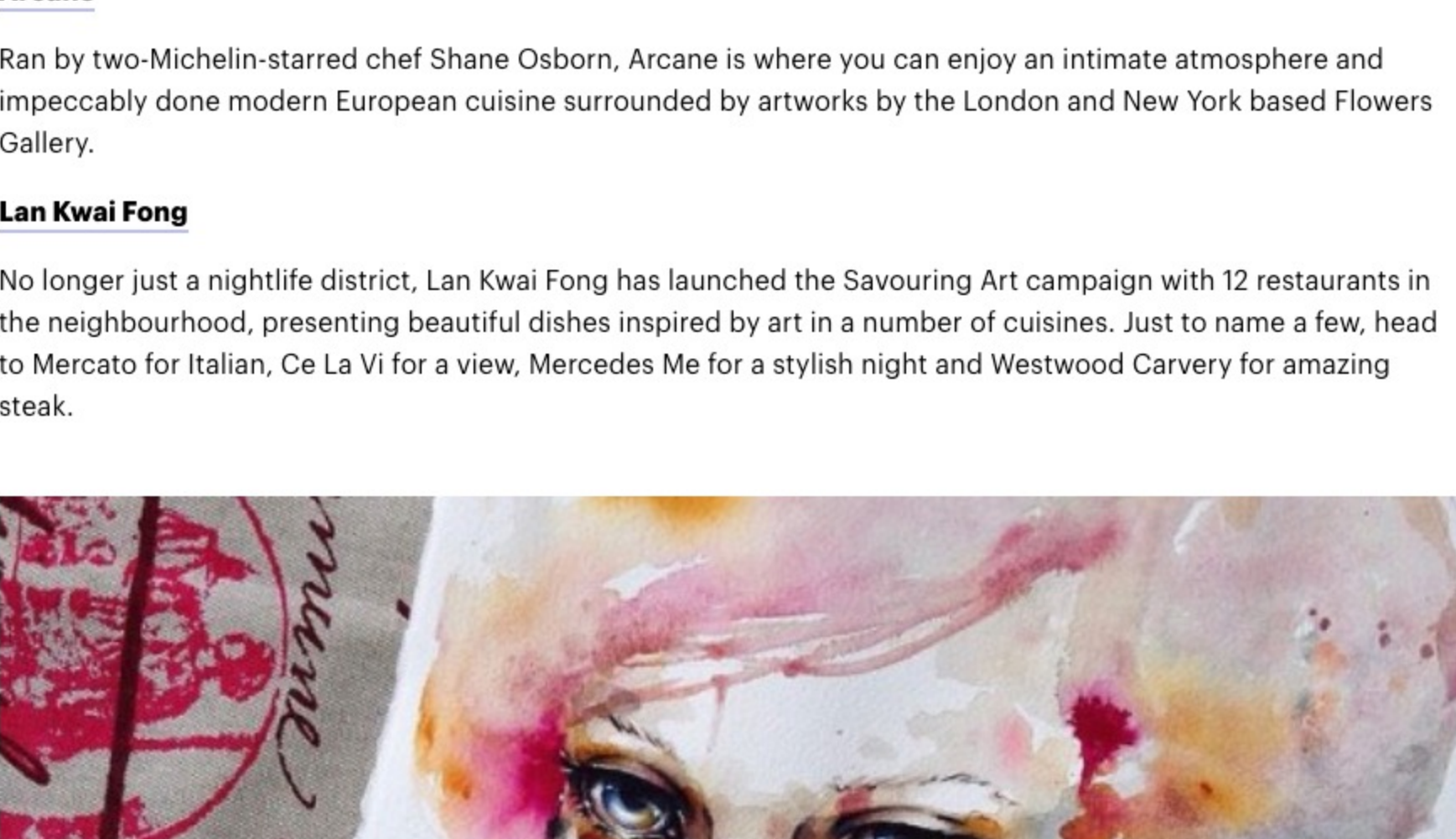
### Get dinner at...

#### Arcane

Ran by two-Michelin-starred chef Shane Osborn, Arcane is where you can enjoy an intimate atmosphere and impeccably done modern European cuisine surrounded by artworks by the London and New York based Flowers Gallery.
