
FOREST HILLS BAPTIST CHURCH

HIS PERSONAL TESTIMONY

"Faith is a belief that God is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

This verse from Hebrews aptly describes the faithful walk of Dr. Sam Boyd, the new pastor of Forest Hills Baptist Church. From his early childhood, Dr. Boyd's life has been characterized by his desire to live in the center of God's will. It is evident through his experiences that God has blessed his obedience.

A native of Bluefield, West Virginia, Dr. Boyd moved to Bristol, Tennessee at the age of seven. He joined First Baptist Church of Bristol, Virginia at the age of nine and matured into a gifted athlete, artist, singer, and leader in both his youth group and high school. As an architecture major at the University of Tennessee-Knoxville, Sam began to sense God moving in his life.
