Will your family eat tonight?

Osha Sewell couldn't always say yes ... until she discovered that 412 Food Rescue delivered surplus food to the Steel Valley Family Center.

"I'd have two hands out, weighing what I should do: buy food or pay rent. You can't say no to food when you've got children," Osha said. **"As a parent, 412 Food Rescue means not having to choose between putting a roof over my head or food in my child's mouth."**

Mercedes Williams has been there. That's why today, she's a 412 #FoodRescueHero.

"I was a single mother of two several years ago. So many things are thrown at you as a parent! The second I got a paycheck, it was gone. At times I'd have \$23 left to buy food until the next payday."

Those days are behind Mercedes now. She earned a college degree, got married and has a great job with Pittsburgh Public Schools, a nonprofit that donates surplus food to 412 Food Rescue. In her car soon after downloading the 412 Food Rescue app, she heard her phone ding.

"I was literally driving right past a spot where food needed to be picked up. I just couldn't pass by without stopping. In 15 minutes, Jubilee Kitchen had bananas and lettuce, and I was back at work. It was my first rescue," she said.

"You can't put a price tag on that experience. Think about all the people I may have helped."
