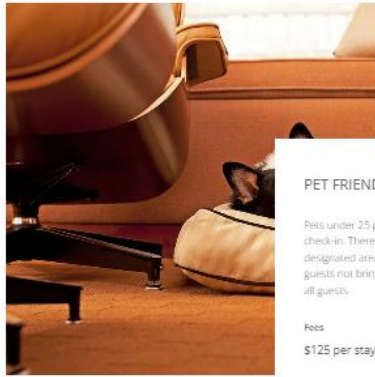


Rooftop Pool
