## DUTIES

The following has been done in support of visual and performance art collaborations between artists in East Africa made possible by community efforts spearheaded by Rukia Hatibu: All projects have either been fundraised for or supported out of pocket.

**June 2018:** The Annoyin'Artist Festival Vol 1- Arusha's first collaborative art festival of its kind. The event featured Tanzanian poets and musicians, and two female visual artists Sungi Mlengeya (Exhibition - Arusha, Tanzania) and Ethel Tawe (Live painting - Yaunde, Cameroon).

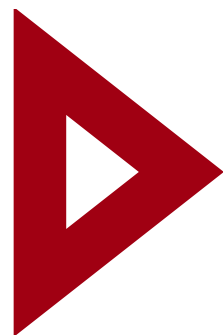




- **October 2018:** Community Fundraiser event for the launch of the City Beautification Project. The event included visual art exhibition from emerging local artists and a dance performance from an established local dance group.



- **December 2018: LAUNCH OF THE CITY BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT IN NJIRO, ARUSHA** - Succeeded in the construction and installation of a bus stop/shade for the public, containing a backdrop of a collaborative artwork of a Kenyan male artist (Muchiri Symo) and Tanzanian female artist (Sungi Mlengeya).



- **February 2019:** Curated and organized a visual art exhibition titled “What Does it Mean To Be African?” in collaboration with Alliance Francaise Arusha and Samuel Mwanjo – an emerging cartoonist. The event built awareness about the City Beautification project and the power of meaningful collaborations among local artists.

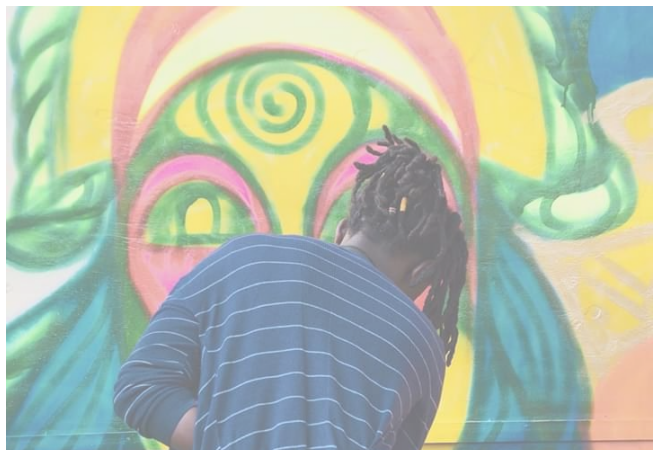
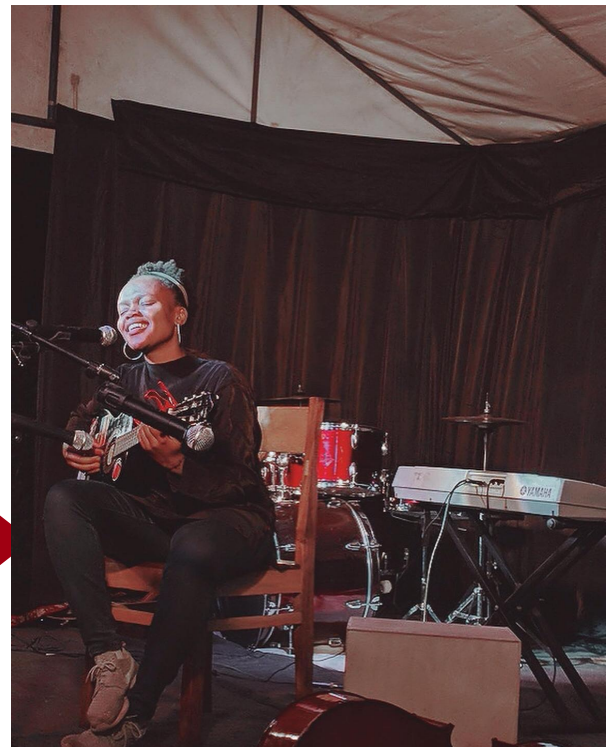




\* **February 2019:** Organized a successful visual art exhibition titled “The Skirts” celebrating female artists in Arusha.

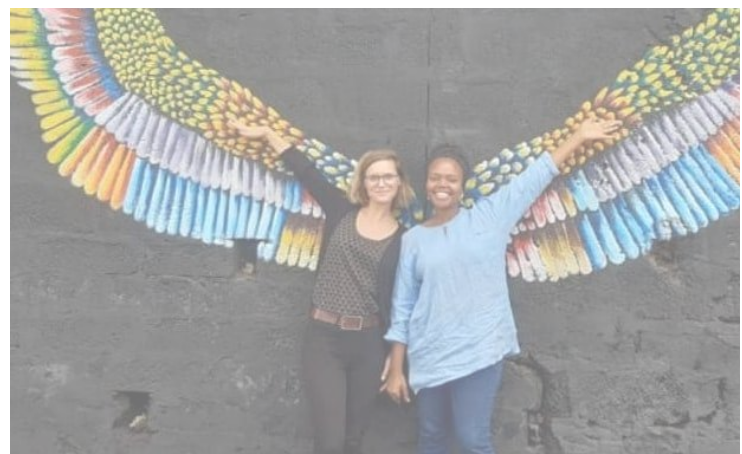
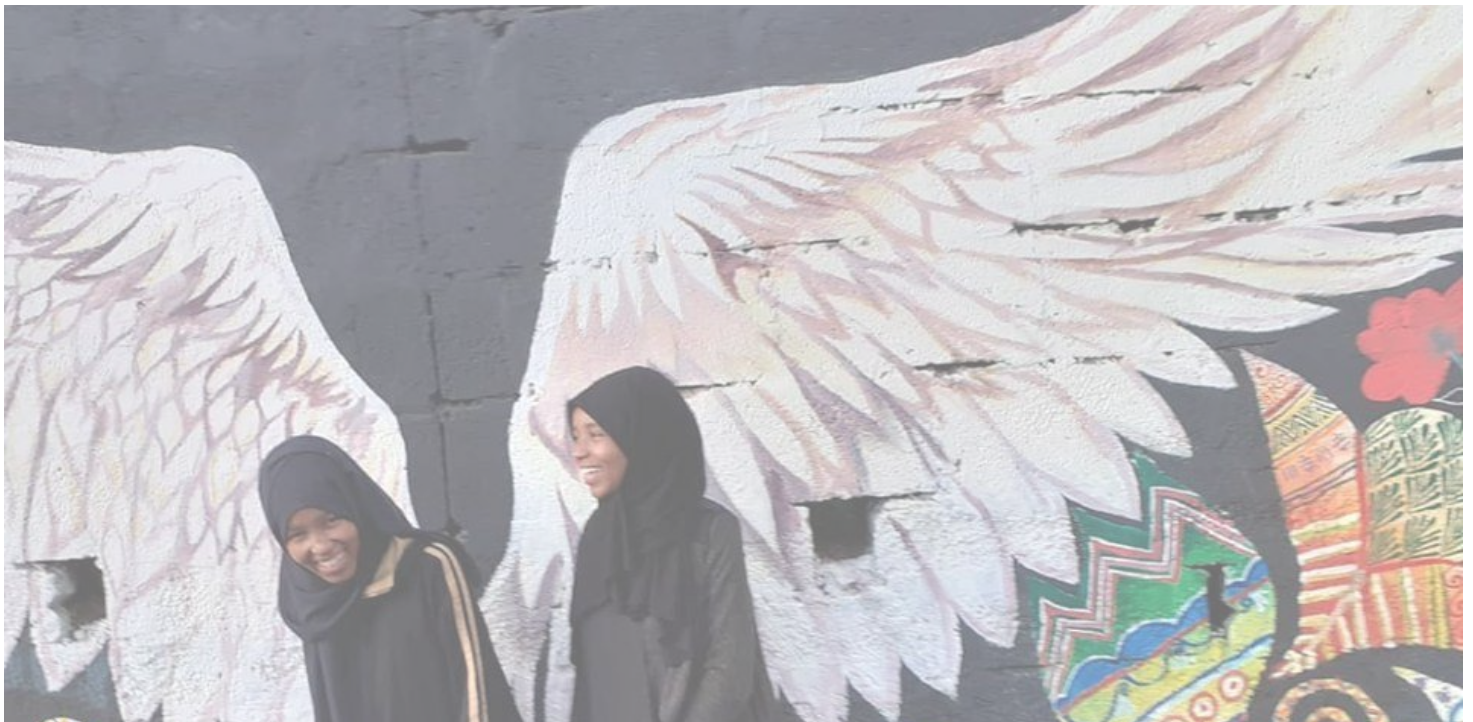

Conducting “Creative Capacity Building” and Critical Thinking activities.

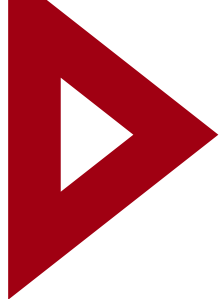
Organizing “Build-It” Workshops where students learn technical skills during the prototyping of real life solutions.

Coaching and preparation of students in public speaking and project presentation.

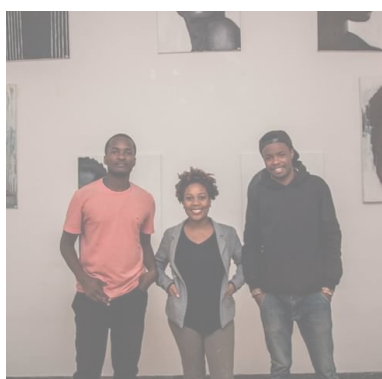
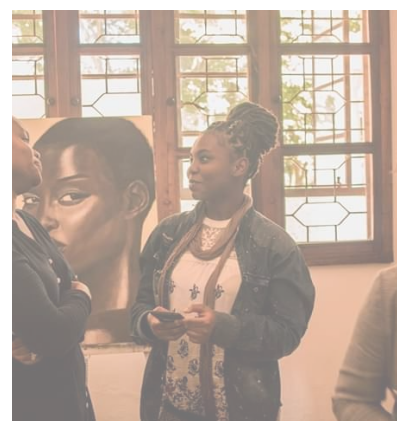
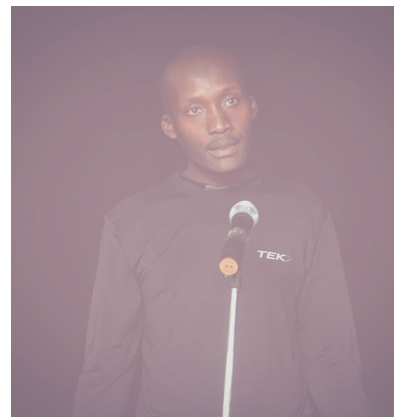
