QUALIFICATIONS

In order to qualify for our **skilled care inpatient rehab services**, a patient...

- Must be hospitalized as an **"acute care inpatient"** for a minimum of **three consecutive midnights** within the last 30 days.
- Must require **at least one** skilled service
- Must have **Medicare Part A** or **other insurance** with hospital-based, skilled-care benefits

Admissions to the inpatient rehab program are made through the **patient's physician** and the **inpatient rehab coordinator**. Each patient is evaluated prior to admission to ensure that inpatient rehab is the most appropriate level of care for the patient.
