





In the wake of the escalation of Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, more

Władysław and his wife Lena were dubbed 'unsung heroes' by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees. Lena Grochowska Foundation Kateryna Darynska, a Ukrainian refugee who now works with the foundation, said: "You [travel] with all your family, with one suitcase, and you don't know where you are going... or where you will end up sleeping. But when we arrived, there were chefs, a lot of employees [waiting for us], and we got warm food." "And they fed us, gave us linen, they gave us everything. It was so important to us," she added. The Grochowski family's commitment extends to migrants on the Polish-Belarusian border, further solidifying their impact on the refugee crisis.


