


## Black Women's Equal Pay Day





### About



Black Women's Equal Pay Day represents the day on which black women "caught up" to a white man's earnings from the previous year. Black women working full time, year round, make 69 cents to the white man's dollar.

### **Facts**

In 2023, black women in Louisiana face the highest Wage Gap compared to their white male counterparts.

Hawaii had the lowest wage gap.
In D.C. in 2023, the average wage gap between black women and white men amounted to \$53,934

### All Women's Equal Pay Day

March 12th





All Women's Equal Pay Day represents the day on which the average woman "caught up" to a white man's earnings from the previous year. The average woman working full time, year round, makes 84 cents to the white man's dollar.

### **Facts**

Equal Pay Day originated in 1996 as a public awareness event to illustrate the gap between men's and women's pay.

It has since been broken down further to show how different demographics feel the wage gap.








# Asian American Women's Equal Pay Day April 3rd





Asian American women working full time, year round, make 93 cents to the white man's dollar.

### **Facts**

Asian American Women's Equal Pay Day includes
Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander Women.
When disaggregating the data, South East Asian and
Pacific Islander Women experience a larger pay gap.
For example, Burmese Women earn only 52 for every
white man's dollar.

### About

LGBTQIA+ Equal Pay Day is held to raise awareness about the lack of wage gap data available for the LGBTQIA+ Community.

The U.S. Census Bureau does not currently collect the necessary information.

### **Facts**

While the data is lacking, it is known that what wage gap there is is magnified for transgender and gender non-conforming individuals, LGBTQIA+ people of color, immigrants, and other marginalized identities.

## Latina Equal Pay Day







Latina Equal Pay Day represents the day on which the average woman "caught up" to a white man's earnings from the previous year. Latinas working full time, year round, make 57 cents to the white man's dollar.

### **Facts**

According to the Institute for Women's Policy Research, the trends between 2002 and 2022 show it will take until 2207 for all Latinas with earnings to catch up to white

Full time, year round working Latinas would catch up in 2171.

### Native Women's Equal Pay Day

November 21st





Native Women's Equal Pay Day represents the day on which the average woman "caught up" to a white man's earnings from the previous year.

Asian American women working full time, year round, make 59 cents to the white man's dollar.

### **Facts**

If broken down by Tribal Nation, some Native
American women are paid even less.
Data in 2023 showed that the majority of Native
American Mothers are the breadwinners in their
families. Because of the pay gap, they struggle to
achieve economic security for their families.
