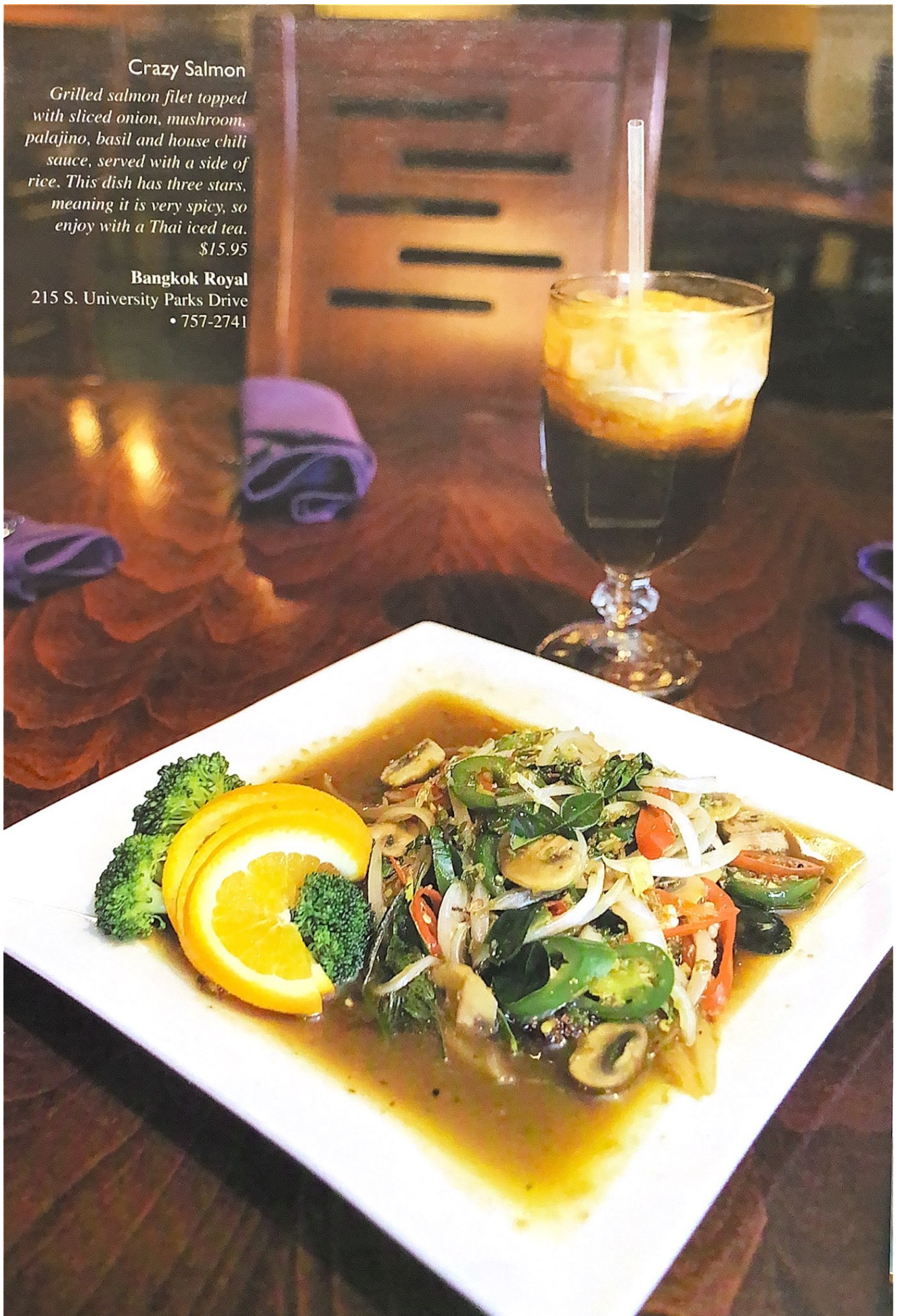
**Crazy Salmon**
