

A hearty serving of slow-cooked beef broth simmered with onion and ginger and infused with spices like anise, nutmeg, cinnamon, chamomile, lemongrass and citrus. Aromatic herbs and savory rice noodles round out this traditional Vietnamese dish that is said to promote good health and is served in a clay pot. \$5.40

R&R Burger


Half-pound double meat burger topped with two slices of cheese, bacon, ham, onion rings and grilled onions and jalapenos. \$7.31
