Now, more than ever, the amount and quality of leisure time is an important family priority. We have filled every corner of *NICKELODEON*SPLAT CITY with exciting and memorable activities that kids and parents can enjoy doing together."

Highlights of the kid-dedicated attractions in the area include:

- *Mega Mess-a-Mania*: The greatest moments in *NICKELODEON* antics and mess-making from such shows as *Double Dare*TM and *What Would You Do?*TM combine to create this hilarious and wacky game show in which everyone participates. The resident Slimeologist and Gakmeister team up with the show's host to lead participants through a variety of stunts and challenges that revolve around GAKTM, Green Slime, pies, water and general mess. The 30-minute show occurs several times daily, with the unpredictable nature of the events ensuring that no two shows are ever alike.
- *GAK Kitchen*: Here, hungry visitors can watch the Gakmeister, Ms. Darla Boogair, concoct the tons of wondrous, messy delectables used on stage in Mega Mess-a-Mania. A section of the kitchen is also open for visitors to enjoy a variety of snack foods, including *Green Slime Slushes* and *Gak de Jour*.
- *Green Slime Zone*: This interactive pipework maze through **SPLAT CITY**'s central slime de-finery operation allows explorers to view the secret Green Slime purification process. Explorers are encouraged to tread carefully as a wrong move may cause a pipe to burst overhead, a stream to unexpectedly gush from nowhere, or a watery spray to hit someone right in the face. Slime Field Control Positions, complete with levers, handles, buttons, and pressure release nozzles, dot the perimeter of the zone and allow the less adventurous to take aim at targets within the maze.

- *Crystal Slime Aerobic Mining Maze*: The thrill of "mining" for Green Slime crystals comes alive for both kids and parents in this huge climb structure. An obstacle course within the structure welcomes kids to beat their personal-best times through challenges similar to the basic training activities featured on *Nickelodeon GUTS!*TM
- *Green Slime Transfer Truck*: Visitors can investigate dials and gauges, turn levers and valves, push buttons, and twist hoses to achieve unpredictable reactions on this specially equipped scientific vehicle. A live show featuring the park's resident Slimeologist, Professor Greenstain, occurs regularly at the truck with the professor enlisting help from curious onlookers to make scientific tests on field samples of Green Slime.
- *The Slime Derrick*: Towering above the area, this 35-foot structure acts as a tremendous pressure relief valve for the relentless force of Green Slime below. At regularly scheduled intervals, natural Green Slime from the earth bursts from the top of the derrick in an awe-inspiring watery spray sure to splatter passers-by. (Note: Beware of the SplatZone. Visitors standing within the zone are bound to get wet when the Slime Derrick erupts!)

Other colorful and inventive attractions in the new area include a Double Dare Slime Shot Challenge game, a Slime Shower photo spot opportunity, and the Green Slime Mining Car Coaster, (formerly known as the Blue Streak). **NICKELODEON SPLAT CITY** is located between the County Fair themed area and Forest-of Fun children's area.
