Netizens rallied together against Isa and his friends, with another Twitter user urging more people “to expose foolish pranks made by this group (Isa and his friends).”

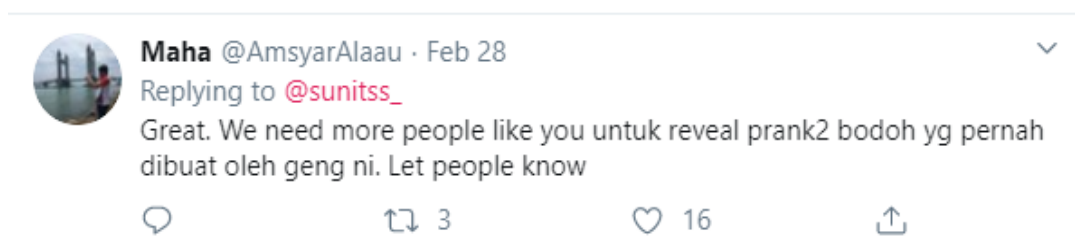
