The sixth season of Outlander will come to an end on May 1st and with a seventh season already in production, lead actor Sam Heughan is set for some *serious* bank.

But the Highland warrior has the credentials to match, and with those credentials comes a busy yet lavish lifestyle.

Today, we'll be taking a dive into Sam Heughan's rich lifestyle and how he spends his millions.

## A Journey to Seven Figures

Sam Heughan wasn't always a multimillionaire, and there was a time where the Scottish actor had a few pennies to his name. Despite having a few scattered acting roles, Heughan had his big break as Jamie Fraser in Outlander.

As far back as 2017, Heughan was making about \$100,000 dollars per episode. That's *some* spending money, but over the course of thirteen episodes in season three, he made approximately \$1,300,000 dollars — and that's just from Outlander.

He starred in Bloodshot alongside Vin Diesel and is also slated to appear in Text For You with Priyanka Chopra Jonas. *And* we're also excited to see the actor Mr. Malcolm's List.

All in all, Sam's personal wealth is roughly estimated at \$6,000,000 dollars. Whew!

And that's not counting the capital he's invested into his business ventures.

The Love of Brand-building

We've said it before, the Scottish philanthropist and actor is as dedicated to fitness as anyone can be. The man knows his stuff. In fact, he's *so* passionate about being fit that he founded and promoted a movement called My Peak Challenge.

But we'll get to that — we're not missing out a chance to talk about the hot Scot's fitness routine.

Now, speaking of how Heughan knows his stuff, what a lot of fans don't know about the actor is his business ventures. He founded the Great Glen Company as a way to share authentic Scottish products as well as culture with the rest of the world.

And through the Great Glen Company in 2020, Heughan launched his very own whisky brand — The Sassenach. This is fitting for the actor since he's one of the few actors being considered to replace Daniel Craig as James Bond.

Just like Bond made the martini cocktail an iconic drink in the film industry, Heughan is apparently going along the same lines with whisky. The whisky is *so* good, in fact, that it earned a double gold medal at the 2020 San Francisco World Spirits Competition.

We're thinking — if Sam *does* get chosen as the next bond, *maybe* change his drink from a vodka martini to Sassenach whisky. It'd be fitting, don't you think?

But Sassenach is just the tip of the iceberg for Heughan.

Cairn Mor Creative, which he's listed as a creative arts firm and set up in 2015, boasted total assets of over \$3.6 million dollars in 2021. After creditor payments were paid off, the firm reported shareholder funds of over \$3.1 million dollars.

The man is a growing business mogul, and he's just going to go up from here, in our opinion.

In any case, with his business going so well, Heughan saw a huge increase in his net worth and that was his chance to buy a sweet looking ride.

# The Audi and the Kilt

If we were Sam, we would've probably bought the latest Mercedes and be done with it. It's stylish, it's sexy, and it screams corporate. But hey, we're not Sam, unfortunately — but we *do* know one particular car that the actor spent some of his money on.

He reportedly owns a cherry-red Audi R8 Spyder, and that's no ordinary supercar. Prices *start* at \$160,000 dollars to a little over *\$200,000* dollars!

The 5.2 liter V10 engine was developed specially by Lamborghini and churns out 562 pure German horsepower. And with a 0 to 60 in a mind-boggling 3.1 seconds, we're imagining Heughan tearing through the Scottish highlands in a leather jacket and a matching kilt.

That's a very specific image, we know, and that's because Heughan uploaded a picture of exactly that on his Instagram. And in the iconic words of a fan, there's nothing like a man in a leather jacket and kilt standing next to his cherry-red Audi.

And trust us, that image is gonna stay in our minds for a while!

### Sam's Love For Traveling

We're thinking of the Audi R8 and imagining a smiley-faced Sam Heughan driving through the Scottish highlands.

He's a busy actor with several projects on his plate, there's no denying that. But when Sam has time on his hands, he loves doing what all of us would do if we had a couple million dollars in the bank.

## First, His Homeland — Scotland!

There are perks of being the lead in one of the highest rated shows on TV, and one of them is traveling.

Outlander boasts a wide range of locations from the Scottish highlands, so it's pretty easy for Sam to travel about and visit places he's never seen before.

On his birthday in 2014, Heughan had an off day and took the chance to sneak off set and climb to the top of Schiehallion. Locals call it the mountain of the fairies, which is a gorgeous name for a magical place.

According to the actor, it was some of the most dramatic scenery he'd ever seen, with snow-covered tips, incredible wildlife, and an overall magic that he'll never forget.

### In And Around Glasgow

If you like Sam Heughan as much as we do, you'll know that getting outdoors is *hugely* important to him. Everything from trekking, to rock climbing, to even mountain climbing is something that's very appealing to him.

When he's got some time on his hands, Heughan gets into his Audi R8 Spyder and drives a little outside of Glasgow to Loch Lomond.

Over there, he loves climbing up the countless Munros that are just a little farther away. In Scotland, mountains that have a height of over 3,000 feet are called Munros, and according to Heughan, he's done about twenty or thirty Munros and always goes back to climb up more.

That sounds amazing and everything, but we're just thinking of the fuel costs of the Audi R8. It's a good thing he has a steady income, because if it were us, we'd be walking all the way.

## When Outside Scotland

Sam really loves visiting this little place called Yorkville in Toronto. Whether it's for a press tour or just traveling for leisure, he prefers to stay at the luxurious Hazelton Hotel.

A night's stay there could set you back a little over \$150 dollars, and Sam loves to stay for a few days at least to take in the local environment.

The hotel has an incredible selection of restaurants that Heughan digs and he's also said that the people who live and work there are some of the chillest folks he's come across.

### The Multimillion Dollar Homes

In November of 2021, Sam made one of his more extravagant purchases when he spent one million dollars on a farmhouse near Glasgow.

This was on *top* of three other homes he already owned at that time, and the total cost of all three homes was approximately \$1.5 million dollars.

Hey, if you're raking in hefty paychecks, it makes perfect sense to spend a few of them on a permanent residence.

The Glasgow farmhouse features four converted bedrooms, modern decor and detailing. The kitchen itself is large, with a massive island in the middle. The million dollar farmhouse also has a gorgeous patio and a double garage.

While the farmhouse is breathtaking, what made us love it even *more* is the fact that Heughan chose the farmhouse because of its distinct look and feel to the locations and houses seen in Outlander.

But this is what sent us over the edge.

The farmhouse was built in 1775, the same year that season six of Outlander is set in. Was part of the season filmed at this location? We don't know, but we're sure it influenced the Scottish actor in some way.

## Sam's Acts of Philanthropy

Let's go back to Heughan's passion for fitness.

Whenever his chiseled jawline appears on screen, you can *see* the hard work he put in to make that happen. He's athletic *and* he's got an entrepreneurial spirit.

Remember the My Peak Challenge that the hot Scot founded? Well, if you're a member of MPC, you pay an annual membership fee of ninety British pounds or somewhere around \$120 dollars.

In exchange, you get a twelve-month training plan that has a step-by-step guide on how to perform daily exercises, including motivational videos starring Heughan himself. There's also a *huge* recipe collection from expert nutritionists that members can use for their own dietary goals.

But MPC has loftier goals.

To date, MPC has more than ten *thousand* active members across 80 countries, and these members have helped raise over one *million* dollars to fully fund a clinical research trial in partnership with blood cancer charity, Bloodwise.

The MPC has also raised funds to underwrite the first full-time director for Cahonas Scotland, an organization that helps educate people about testicular cancer.

Heughan's goal for My Peak Challenge doesn't end here.

He wants the member count to keep increasing and for more charities to partner with My Peak Challenge so that members have a wider set of choices to donate their money.

Honestly, we thought we couldn't love the Scotsman more, but after learning about this — we're head over heels.
