Act Quickly to Comply With Ohio's Statute of Limitations

Ohio law defines how much time you have to file your lawsuit. If it is not filed on time, you could lose the legal ability to file it at all. Accordingly, you generally have:

- Two years to file your personal injury lawsuit, per Ohio Revised Code Section 2305.10
- Two years to file your wrongful death lawsuit, per Ohio Revised Code Section 2125.02

How Our Delaware Bicycle Accident Lawyers Prove the Elements of Negligence

A Strong Evidence Collection Can Pinpoint the At-Fault Driver's Negligence

Vehicle versus bicycle accidents can have many different causes. To prove the cause of your accident, we build a persuasive case file that includes:

1. Medical records and bills that document the cause of your injuries and their current and future costs. We also work with your treatment team to obtain a detailed written prognosis that documents your future needs.
2. Photos and videos that depict the accident scene (before and after the collision) and the condition of the at-fault vehicle and your bicycle. We also obtain photos of your injuries and their severity.
3. Official first responder reports, including police, fire, and medical. Whenever possible, we request narratives and diagrams from the investigating officer and accident reconstruction professionals.

Your case file will include proof of income to ensure you are accurately compensated for the time your injuries have and will prevent you from returning to work. We also collect evidence that could be difficult for you to obtain on your own, including official reports, death certificates, and forensic evidence.
