Lara sighs and presses on, refusing to slow down.

LARA CROFT

(under her breath)
Better safe than sorry...

EXT. EGYPTIAN RUINS - LATE AFTERNOON

Lara pulls up to what looks like abandoned rubble, almost indistinguishable from the landscape. The Great Pyramids of Giza are visible far off in the background.

LARA CROFT

This is it. Start looking for any inscriptions on the pieces. I'm

going to start looking on the other side.

The pair splits up, scouring the remains of the long forgotten structure.

ABRAHAM

(calling out)

Find anything?

LARA CROFT

Not yet...

Lara brushes away some sand from a piece of the building.

LARA CROFT

Wait... Abraham come take a look at this!

Abraham rushes over to Lara and peers over her shoulder.

ABRAHAM

Hold on... What? This is Sanskrit. I didn't expect to find ancient Sanskrit writings in Egypt. And why way out here, of all places?

LARA CROFT

I told you before Abraham, there's more to what we're looking for than you think.

Abraham turns to Lara, slightly annoyed.

**ABRAHAM** 

Well what are we looking for, Lara? Do you care to explain anything now that you've brought me out here?

Lara hesitates. She's conflicted, and it shows on her face.

LARA CROFT

I can't tell you. The more people I involve in this the more dangerous it gets. I've learned that lesson too many times over now...

#### **ABRAHAM**

Holy-!

Abraham is cut off by another round of gunfire. He ducks behind the rubble.

LARA CROFT

Get down, Abraham! Don't move until
I say it's safe!

Lara draws her pistol and begins moving through the rubble, taking cover and returning suppressive fire to shield her movements. She dispatches the attackers with relative ease before returning to Abraham.

**ABRAHAM** 

(incredulous)

What. The. Hell?! What was that all about? Did you know they were coming?!

LARA CROFT

I had a feeling they might.

**ABRAHAM** 

"They" who? Who are they? Why did they just try to kill us?!

Lara checks the horizon warily before sitting down on a rock. She takes a deep breath.

LARA CROFT

I really shouldn't have brought you out here...

ABRAHAM

It's a little late for that now, isn't it? Now that I've almost died once today, I think I deserve an explanation.

Lara sighs again.

LARA CROFT

Those men were sent from an organization called Trinity. I think they're trying to find something called the Slab of Eternity. It's an ancient relic said to have been forged outside of time as we know it. If Trinity get the Slab, they'll have control of time itself. That's why I've got to

find it first. I didn't they'd already caught up to me...

**ABRAHAM** 

The Slab of Eternity?

Abraham shakes his head, confused.

ABRAHAM

Why have I never heard of it?

LARA CROFT

No one really knows where it came from. There are only scraps - mere morsels - of information about it. Hunting down whatever I could find led me here. And now Trinity is here too.

Abraham is silent for a moment. He looks from Lara, to the bodies, and back.

**ABRAHAM** 

Then we better get that stone translated. I may have almost died today, but you also saved my life. When I'm done we can call it even, yeah?

Lara lets a quiet chuckle out as Abraham gets to work on the translation.

EXT. EGYPTIAN RUINS - EVENING

ABRAHAM

Okay, Lara, come look at this. See this line here? It says, "Under the shade of Khufu's rest, truth is revealed."

LARA CROFT

Khufu's rest -- that must refer to the Great Pyramid! So it must have something to do with the pyramid's shadow. Does it say anything about a time of day?

ABRAHAM

Right here. From what I can make out, this phrase roughly translates to "morning's light".

#### LARA CROFT

Okay, then we're looking for the shadow cast by the pyramid in the morning. We've got to get there before sunrise tomorrow. No doubt Trinity will be hot on our trail; we have to stay one step ahead.

## EXT. THE GREAT PYRAMID OF GIZA - DAWN

## LARA CROFT

Abraham sits up, stretching.

## ABRAHAM

No, I can't just sit around twiddling my thumbs knowing what's at stake here. I was thinking about it last night... The Slab of Eternity. Those men. Trinity. None of it seems real. But somehow, I trust you Lara. I want to help.

## LARA CROFT

Abe, it's too dangerous. Trinity is ruthless. Just let me handle this, please...

Abraham puts his hand on Lara's shoulder.

## **ABRAHAM**

If something happens to me, that's on me. Not you. Don't forget that. I'm choosing this.

Abraham scoots back into the seat to gather his gear.

#### **ABRAHAM**

Besides, I'm not entirely useless, am I? Who's going to do all the reading if I don't tag along?

Lara smiles once again, and opens the truck's door.

#### LARA CROFT

Fine, but stay close to me and call out if you see anything.

Lara and Abraham make their way to where the Great Pyramid's shadow is being cast. The early hour has rendered the base of the pyramid devoid of tourists. A perfect time to search the area.

## ABRAHAM

So what exactly do you think we're going to find here that a million people haven't stepped on before?

LARA CROFT

## LARA CROFT

## LARA CROFT

(pointing at her map)

Yes, one of the maps I found before referenced an ancient structure in that area. I'd bet anything we're meant to go there next!

#### **ABRAHAM**

Okay then! Let's... Oh... No...

Abraham's gaze drifts past Lara. He's looking at several blacked out Humvees speeding their way.

**ABRAHAM** 

Uhh, Lara?! Looks like Trinity's on its way!

Lara turns to see the vehicles kicking up dust, speeding towards her. She scrambles to gather all her belongings and starts running.

LARA CROFT

Quickly, Abraham! Get back to the truck! Run!

As the Humvees draw near, bullets start whipping past Abraham and Lara. Metal crunches as some of the rounds hit the truck. Lara slams her foot on the pedal, racing towards the city.

ABRAHAM

Go, go, go, go!

Abraham fastens his seatbelt, looking terrified.

ABRAHAM

Oh god...

LARA CROFT

Stay with me Abe! Come on, we'll make it!

Abraham glances at Lara, who looks confident and determined. He swallows his fear.

ABRAHAM

Hand me your pistol, I'm gonna try
to scare 'em a little!

Lara hands her weapon over without a second thought.

LARA CROFT

Good luck!

Abraham squeezes several shots off. They don't seem to do much. He focuses in for a couple more. Suddenly, a Humvee's tire explodes into ribbons of rubber. It loses control and crashes into its neighbors.

ABRAHAM

Hell yeah! Did you see that Lara?!

Lara laughs and looks back at the wreckage.

## LARA CROFT

Nice one! There's bound to be much more where that came from!

The truck tears down the street into the city. Lara and Abraham are well on their way to their next stop.

Briefly discuss how you might convey story beats of this scene during gameplay, using in-game narrative systems and techniques.
