Hi Danielle,

You should be proud. You're about to graduate high school and you've already earned college credits — and all during a pandemic. Now, with a few more classes, you can complete your degree close to home right here at Valencia College.

Here's what you need to do to finish what you started:

1 Complete the FAFSA online. (The college's school code is 006750.) The sooner you do this, the more likely you are to receive financial assistance.

2 Fill out the Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes form. This saves you money so you won't be charged an out-of-state rate. (Even as a graduate of a Florida high school, you'll need to complete the form.)

3 Send us your final, official high school transcript as soon as it's available from your high school. You'll want to have it sent directly to Valencia College. For instructions, [click here](#).

If you're a home school student, please [provide us with a Home School Affidavit](#) verifying your high school graduation. You'll also need to submit a letter of intent filed with your county's school district.

4 Submit the Change of Program/Major form. Changing your program from personal interest to an associate degree transitions you from a Dual Enrollment student to a degree-seeking student at the college.

5 Meet with an academic advisor when you're ready to register for classes. An academic advisor can help you determine which classes you should take next to meet your goals.

Please note: As a graduating high school senior, you currently have a hold on your account. This hold will be released when you graduate from high school and submit your transcripts. You will be eligible to begin taking classes on Tuesday, June 21, 2022 (Summer Term B) or later. You will not be able to take full-term summer classes, which begin on Monday, May 19, 2022.
