Disney's Polynesian Village Resort

Located off the Seven Seas Lagoon, Disney's Polynesian Village Resort features a beautiful waterfront spot to enjoy an open fire and perhaps indulge in a s'more. With the added allure of easy access to the Adventureland-favorite snack, DOLE Whip, and the opportunity for picture-perfect firework viewing mere steps away, it's practically perfect. Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort

There's no firepit on Walt Disney World Property with as much fanfare as the one you'll discover at the Meadow Trading Post located on the grounds of Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort. It not only features a true campfire ambience, but also the chance to gather 'round for a cowboy singalong featuring the world's most famous chipmunks: Chip 'n' Dale, of course. Don't worry if you don't have the ingredients for s'mores; you can buy a kit from the Chuckwagon Snack Bar. Plan for a long evening — you'll catch Movies Under the Stars here after the campfire.

Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge - Jambo House

What could be more captivating than savoring an open fire in the heart of the African savanna? The distinctive setting of this firepit, where you can relish the warmth while gazing upon giraffes, zebras, and other animals, earns it a top spot on my list of must-do fire experiences. Far from the hustle and bustle of Genie+ and bus schedules, the fire at Animal Kingdom Lodge is one of the most serene places to roast a marshmallow.

Cinderella Castle Suite
