"Good times, good friends and great memories" is what Kelly's Corner on Cayuga Drive says it's all about. Since owner Chad Robertson opened it's doors back in 2010, the bar has welcomed guests 365 days a year to enjoy their time-honored specials like 45-cent chicken wings on Sundays and Mondays.

To mark its 10 years in business, Kelly's Corner is hosting an anniversary celebration that kicks off at 5 p.m. on Saturday at 524 Cayuga Drive.
