

Region l Contest 2024 Report

IMPACT REPORT

Student Participation

The 2024 Ohio History Day Region 1 Contest saw increased participation from last year, with 175 students from four different schools participating.

- 37% of students participating were in middle school; 63% in high school
- 44% of students were returning to the program after having participated at least once before
- We added a new teacher, who brought 15 students from her class
- 4 returning teachers 5+ years' participation
- Region 1 is #4 in the State for size, after Cleveland, Columbus, & Youngstown
- Notable student projects included cultural history, history of science, and Black history
- State results: 3 Region 1 students qualified for the National Contest!
- Center for Archival Collections hosted a Research Day for participating students in January



Volunteer Participation

- 31% were BGSU students or faculty/staff
- Volunteer engagement from NW Ohio partners; Midstory, U of Toledo, Allen County Museum, Tiffin University, National Museum of the Great Lakes, Kent State Tuscarawas, Wood Co. Parks, all represented
- Wood County Museum hosted a table on the Mezzanine with giveaways and promos
