Seasonally decorated with snowflake cups and a wreath poster on the shop window, Orée's marketing suggests their chai latte is strong candidate for the best on the St. John's Wood High Street. Upon lifting the drink to one's lips, the silky consistency and hint of cinnamon are made instantly clear.

Unfortunately, the first waft is merely a customer tease as the beverage lacks a depth of flavor and sufficient sweetening. In addition, we noticed the cup was not particularly warm to the

touch, and the contents of the drink could have been heated more thoroughly

With £3.30 for a regular or £3.70 for a large, chai lattes from Laurents are by far the holiday drink standout.

Notes

Much to our dismay, Notes' chai latte fell flat in more ways than one. The primary issue with this drink was its utter lack of flavor. If you are looking for a full-bodied beverage infused with spices and sweetness, a chai latte from Notes is not your best bet.

Instead, we found the drink to be weak and oddly salty. For these reasons, we cannot condone spending £3.40 for takeaway or £3.60 to drink in-store for an underwhelming chai latte.
