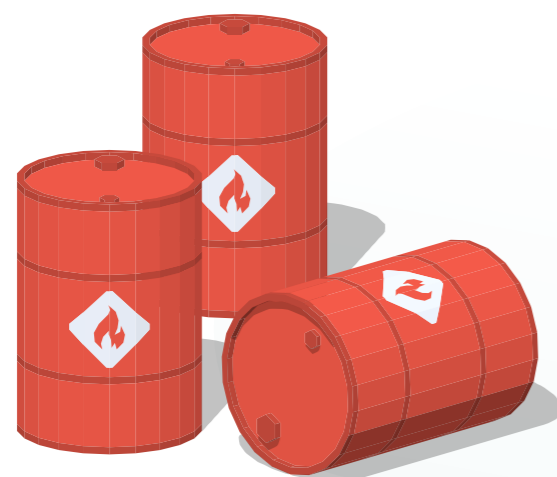

LESS FOSSIL FUEL USAGE

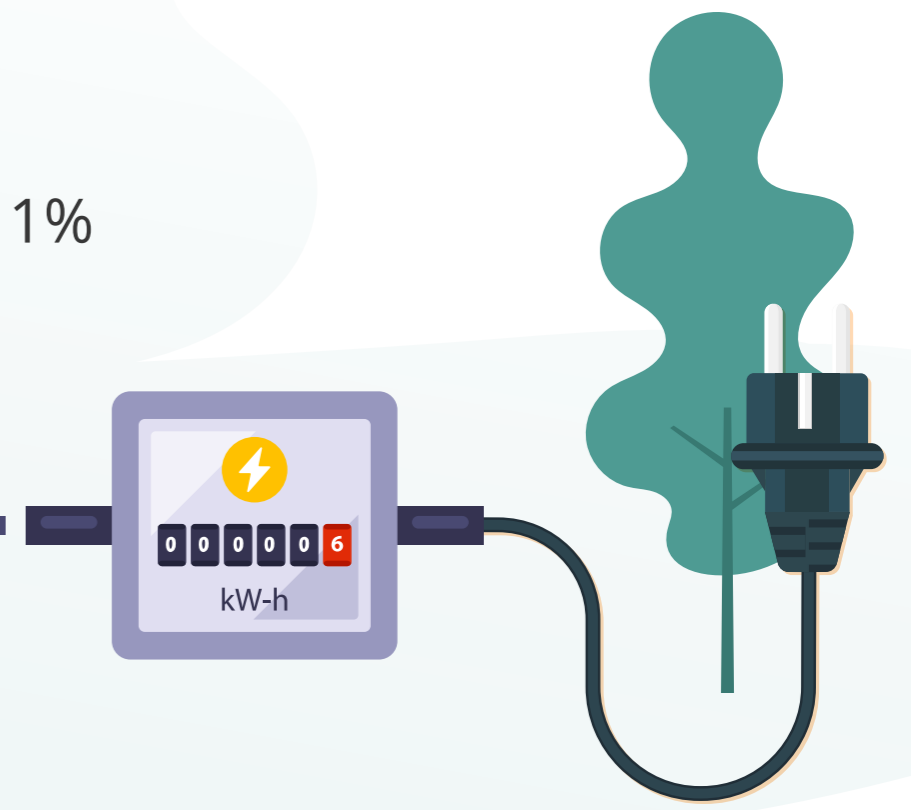
