As we gear up to celebrate Earth Day, we're honored to share the story behind our Mexican Blankets that are created sustainably and ethically.

Each are made with 100% recycled material from school uniforms. This recycled yarn is not dyed, and water is not used in the manufacturing process, making each blanket an eco-friendly choice for your home.

It takes about eight uniforms to create one Mexican Blanket, effectively reducing waste, promoting sustainable practices, and bolstering female artisans in Mexico, who make each blanket by hand.

Benevolence LA has sold more than 570,000 Mexican Blankets to date. Our recycling efforts have kept over 4.5 million garments from ending up in landfills.

Each blanket purchase promotes the textile traditions of the Tlaxcala region that have been inherited from generation to generation.
