► This pizzeria and cider bar puts a west-coast spin on gourmet Italian food. Innovative, fresh ingredients are responsibly sourced from Dorset, making the pizzas here a cut above the competition. Try "The King Crabber" for a light, summery pizza with the delicate flavour of chilli-infused crab meat, or "The Roasted Larry", which is essentially a Sunday roast on a pizza. There's also apple-sloshing galore, but you'll need to grab a tasting paddle to have any chance of making inroads into their 300-strong cathedral of cider.

Simple ingredients of the best quality are key to the small menu, with the standout dishes including a freshly made pappardelle in a rich, meaty, slow-cooked pork rib sauce. As well as offering intimate dinners on the weekend and a daily deli, Burro e Salvia lets you get your hands dirty with fresh pasta-making workshops.
