

THE ROMANTIC RHINE: BASEL TO AMSTERDAM

HOW MANY CASTLES CAN YOU SPOT? Embark your riverboat in Basel and spend a day in Lucerne, where cobblestone lanes lead to town squares lined with illustrated houses. Stroll along the covered wooden Chapel Bridge, and gazing upward, discover the Renaissance paintings that adorn its interior. See the Lion Monument to Swiss mercenaries who lost their lives in the French Revolution, described by Mark Twain as "the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world." A gondola flies you up Mt. Pilatus, home to dragons with healing powers, and a cogwheel train takes you twisting down again through mountain crags and meadows dotted with wildflowers. Sail to Strasbourg, where medieval streets and canals spread out around the pink sandstone cathedral that the poet Goethe called a "sublimely towering and wide-spreading tree of God." If you like, drive to Baden-Baden for a walking tour of this Belle Époque spa town where fashionable people played in the 19th century; it's still a prosperous and cultured town today. Choose between exploring Speyer's cathedral or the romantic ruins of Heidelberg Castle, long an inspiration for poets and painters. Go bicycling in Koblenz or walk to the "German Corner," where milestones of German history are recorded in monuments and artifacts. Gliding along the Rhine, pass castles, historic towns, and vineyards en route to Köln for a walking tour around its twin-spired cathedral. Nearby, a private evening at the Ecolut-Center immerses you in sustainable architecture and dining. Amsterdam's old city is best seen by canal boat, and you'll do just that, followed by a tour of masterworks at the Rijksmuseum. For full day-by-day details, visit tauck.com.
