



Does your customer intend to travel outside of U.S. waters?

Just add the Extended Navigation endorsement to a new business quote

Our Yacht policy allows for traveling in all U.S. or Canadian waters, but not into another country's territorial waters. If your customer intends to venture down Mexico's Pacific coast, or to the Bahamas, specify that when you quote.

Whatever the destination, the endorsement requires that:

- the trip not last longer than 90 days in the Atlantic or 150 days in the Pacific
- the yacht not be unattended while moored
- prior underwriting approval is needed, and we may ask for an itinerary and/or hurricane plan
- the yacht must be in sufficient condition to handle the trip



On the west coast, the Extended Navigation endorsement allows your customers to navigate as far south as San Quintin, Bahia Tortuga, or Cabo San Lucas on the Baja peninsula, or to Puerto Vallarta or Acapulco. Select the farthest intended destination when you quote.

On the east coast, the Extended Navigation endorsement allows yachters to travel to the Bahamas or the Turks and Caicos, but not further south or east.
