

Share a Smile Project was founded on the 4th of November in the year 2016 by Cindy Abad and Regin Rex Teodoro at Mamuyao, Tanay, Rizal. The first outreach activity was held with the Dumagat Remontados, the indigenous community of the said area. From having two volunteers, Share a Smile now have around 100 civilian volunteers with ages ranging as young as 5 years old to 65 years old.

Share a Smile's ultimate goal is to reach out to various communities in far-flung areas to share what we can with them to bring out their smiles and make them feel loved.





We support their education by giving them a backpack with school materials specific to their grade levels.

Share a Smile reaches out to distant tribal communities with scarce electricity sources.

We alleviate this concern by giving a solar-powered lamp to each family of the tribe which they can use at night as they do their house chores, continue their studies, and for emergencies.

Sending pre-loved toys to tribal kids who don't have the means to buy new ones is one way to help them develop their intellect and their emotion as they find joy in play.

Most of the members of the tribe wear overused slippers. Giving them new slippers will ease them as they go on their everyday duties and studies.



Feeding Program

Share a Smile believes that a person needs at least 2-3 meals a day to have the energy to do their tasks, study, and play. Through this program, we aim to provide one of these meals to support the tribe's nutritional needs while also giving them a chance to taste food that is not always available to them.
