Steps to keep the pool water clean

1. Filter the pool water

To maintain a pool, you must filter water and keep the filter in excellent working order. Around 80% of pool water issues may be avoided with this method You must operate the pool's filter system for at least eight hours every day Increase the filtering time if the water is hot.

2.Balance pool water acidity

The pH level and efficiency of the treatment agents, notably disinfectants, will be reduced if the pool water is unbalanced. As a result, when maintaining the pool clean, you must monitor the pH level of the water Pool water should have a pH of between 7 and 7.4 Also, make sure that the alkalinity of the water is between 100 and 200 mg/liter.

3.Disinfect pool water

Every week, the disinfectant level in the pool water must be checked. The water will be clean and sanitary as a result of this. You may choose from a variety of treatment options, including bromine, chlorine, UV, salt electrolysis, and so on.

4.keep your pool algae free

To prevent algae growth in the pool, treat the water with an anti-algae treatment once a week. While applying the algae treatment, ensure the water is balanced and the filters operate correctly.

How to clean your pool daily

- Check for the signs of algae growth and cloudiness. You can start by sweeping the algae growth signs if you find the algae growth signs.
- Check the chlorine levels to make adjustments when required.
- Checking the skimmer nets each morning is also a good idea. Remove any vegetation that has accumulated overnight, as well as any insects that have died.
- If the pool appears foggy, try backwashing your sand filter for a few minutes and seeing how it looks the next day.
