Comprehensive Streaming Service Recommendation Engine

My proposal is about a potential product that would help users of multiple video streaming services such as Netflix, Hulu and Amazon Prime. The product is called <u>showsyoulike.com</u> and it is a search and recommendation engine for streaming TV shows <u>and</u> movies.

Frequently, television shows and movies are limited to one streaming platform, making it hard to get comprehensive recommendations for shows & movies. Additionally, if someone hears about a show they might enjoy, this search engine would help them quickly locate where they can view it and recommend other similar shows across various platforms.

This technology will use a combination of algorithms and artificial intelligence to come up with relevant recommendations. Since the site has a larger library than each streaming service by itself, the recommendations will be more relevant than those on existing stand-alone services.

It will also interact with the API of each streaming service to access the shows available and give the most current results. Depending on availability, the API will also allow users to join a streaming service or purchase pay-per-view shows & movies right on the site.


