Quick on the heels of the Air Dior, the French house continues its streak of collectible kicks

Taking its cues from the skateboarding universe and vintage tennis shoes of the 1980s, Dior's new B27 sneakers embody a sportswear spirit that is pure Kim Jones. Since joining the house in 2018, the artistic director has played a huge role in bringing the maison back into the consciousness the young streetwear crowd. From the Chuck Taylor-inspired B23s to the much-anticipated Air Diors from the Nike collaboration, his trainers have become the most coveted among the sneakerhead collective.

And the B27s are set to be no different. Available in white, black or grey and a choice of low- or high-top styles, they're an emblem for Jones' reinvention of Dior's rich heritage, seen through a modern lens and given a sporty edge. As refined as ever, each pair is embellished with a multi-material finish of smooth calf leather and nubuck with the Dior Oblique Jacquard or the Dior Oblique Galaxy. Get your kicks with Dior this autumn/winter.
