Bowling at the Boiler Room

Florence

Located in the basement of the Stricklin Hotel in downtown Florence, this bowling joint allows you to knock some pins while enjoying live music and craft cocktails. But the entertainment doesn't stop there, the novelty bar also offers its guests skeeball, foosball, shuffleboard and darts. Nothing quite says romance like a friendly game of competition! With its lively but cozy atmosphere, it will be hard to leave at the end of the night. But before you go, be sure to order from their menu that only offers the best dishes from the famous local restaurant Big Bad Breakfast.

See a show at the historic Ritz Theatre

Sheffield

Built in 1927, this theatre is the perfect way to experience some local history and art simultaneously.
