



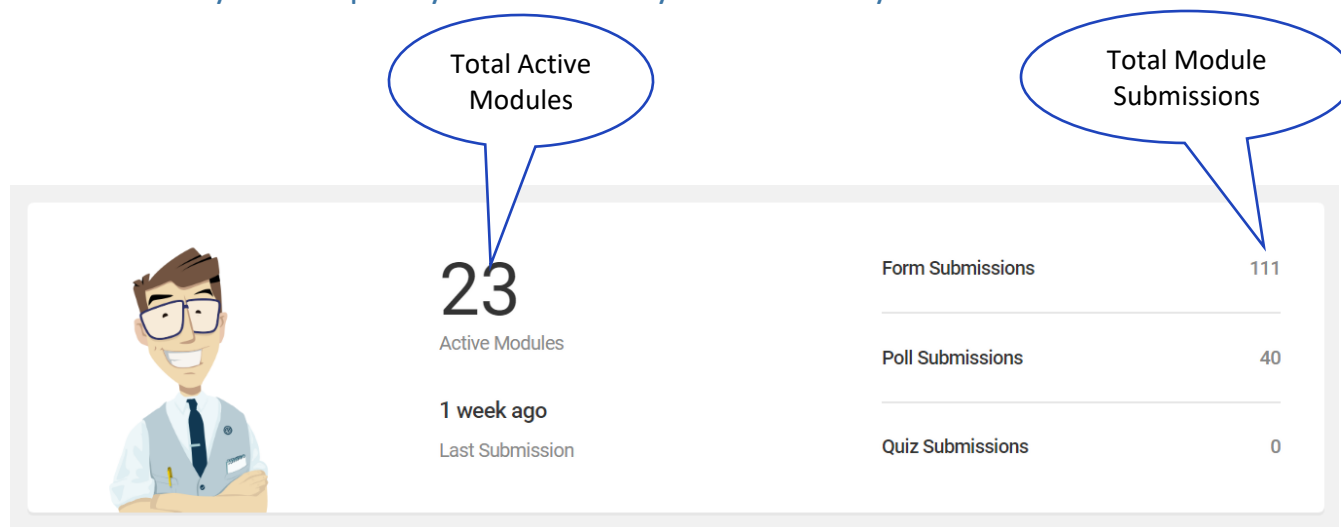
Forminator Pro

Getting Started with Forminator Pro

Forminator Pro is a leading all-in-one form designer in the WordPress plugin repository. Best of all, the plugin comes with a quiz and poll designer to create interactive polls and engaging quizzes. Let's whiz by the dashboard.

Dashboard


The Forminator Pro dashboard is the starting point to view how many active modules you have, remember modules are forms, polls and quizzes. The fantastic part about the dashboard is you can quickly see how many submissions you have from all modules.













Further down in the Forminator Pro dashboard, you'll find three separate sections, one for Forms, Polls and Quizzes. Each section lists the name of modules created, a button to create a module, a link to view all modules and action icons.

Forms

We'll dive into each using the Forms section.

 **Forms**

Create any type of form from one of our pre-made templates, or build your own from scratch.

+ CREATE

View all forms


NAME

When you create a new form, it will appear under the *Name* column.


STATUS

The *Status* column indicates if a Form is published or not. If it is published the status will display a blue symbol. If it is not published, then it is in draft mode, and there is no color symbol displayed.

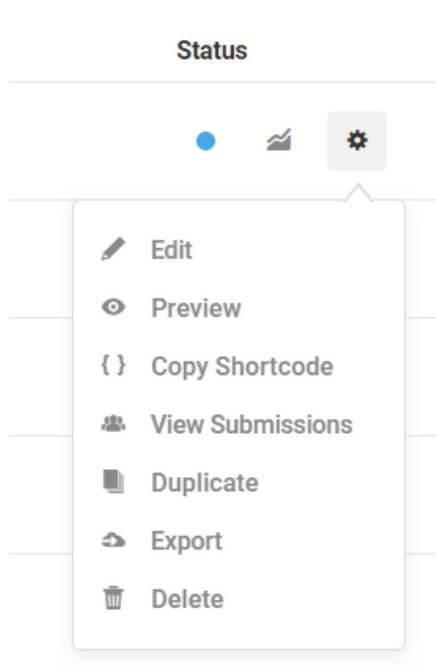
VIEW STATS

The *View Stats* icon  is a link that takes you to the form's stats section that displays the last submission, total views and submissions, and the conversion rate.

COG

The *Cog* icon  displays a dialog box with several action items that you can select to manage your form. In the action box you can edit, preview, copy shortcode, view submissions, duplicate, export and delete your form.

Now the fun part. Continuing with the Cog icon, here you are able to manage each form created.




Let's review the action items under the Cog.


1. EDIT

The Edit icon  quickly takes you to the edit page to make changes to your form.


2. PREVIEW

The Preview icon  instantly pops up a preview of your form saved from the last changes.


3. COPY SHORTCODE

The Copy Shortcode  icon is the magic to display your form in a WordPress page or post. A notice will appear confirming copy.


4. VIEW SUBMISSIONS

The View Submissions  icon leads to a list of contacts that have successfully completed your form.


5. DUPLICATE

The Duplicate icon  allows you to make a replica of your form. This saves you valuable time.

6. EXPORT

The Export icon  will download the form to import to another Forminator Pro installation. A dialog box will appear to copy the form code or to download the form file to import.

7. DELETE

The Delete icon  will delete your form. A dialog box will appear to confirm deletion. Be careful, deleting a form is permanent.

VIEW ALL FORMS

The dashboard shows the last five (5) forms created. Click *View all forms* to see a list of all forms created.

**+ CREATE**

View all forms

CREATE

Yay, it's creation time. Click the blue *+ CREATE* button to begin the process of designing a form. A dialog box will appear to select a form template, we like to save you time, or you can start with a blank canvas.

POLLS AND QUIZZES

The Polls and Quizzes section in the dashboard has the same functions we've covered in Forms.
