LAKEWOOD CHURCH SHOOTING INVESTIGATION (1, 2, 3)

After a February shooting at Houston's Lakewood Church, our team scraped social media sites and requested records from nearly two dozen government agencies to build a timeline of the perpetrator's interactions with law enforcement officials in the decade leading up to the attack. The series led police agencies in Arizona to create a course on how officers can use social media to inform their investigations.

SUSPENDED CASES DATABASE (1, 2)

Created a searchable database of 260,000+ incident reports the Houston Police Department has suspended since 2016 due to lack of personnel, and analyzed how the omission of these reports impacted the city's crime statistics. Dozens of readers responded that the table helped them realize their case was suspended.
