



The entire Guinea-Bissau squad has come down with food poisoning

All 25 travelling squad members have been hospitalised ahead of the Guinea-Bissau vs Morocco fixture.

The entire Guinea-Bissau squad has been hospitalised ahead of their FIFA World Cup qualifier against Morocco. The previous World Cup qualifier between Guinea and Morocco which was supposed to be played in Guinea, had to be postponed because of a military coup. Their team bus was a casualty of the crossfire and the match was cancelled. The Guinea-Bissau crew were eating at their lodging base in Morocco on tuesday night. 15 minutes after their meal both the players as well as the technical staff were experiencing diarrhoea and vomiting.

The Guinea-Bissau Football Federation's Facebook update read:

"All 25 players at mister Baciro Candé's disposal have vomit and diarrhea after dinner tonight.

Equally, the elements of the technical team are in the same situation.

Players are currently being transported to hospital to get more intensive care.

FFGB(Federação de Futebol da Guiné-Bissau) officials have tried unsuccessfully so far to contact the nationality serraleones game commissioner."

The head of the FFGB has made his stance clear, he will not let the players onto the pitch under such circumstances. A match-update is yet to be given by officials.
