PORTSMOUTH-CHESAPEAKE LAND USE STUDY TOWN HALL MEETING

(PORTSMOUTH, VIRGINIA – JUNE 16, 2021) After more than a year of extensive study on critical issues, such as roadway flooding, multimodal transportation, access, parking, land use and utilities, the Portsmouth-Chesapeake Joint Land Use Study has proposed actions to address these issues, and other opportunities that are intended to benefit the Navy, as well as neighborhoods and businesses in surrounding areas.
